

Sustainable Energy to Power Local Job Growth

Western New York Hydropower (WNYHP) is a New York State economic development program from the New York Power Authority (NYPA) that supports new businesses and drives expansion of existing facilities in Western New York. Also known as Expansion Power and Replacement Power, the program distributes 695 megawatts (MW) of competitively priced hydropower generated at NYPA's Robert Moses Niagara Power Project in Lewiston, Niagara County. WNYHP helps business grow in Western New York with renewable 10-year contracts, long-term cost stability and clean, green hydropower.

Western New York Hydropower is available to qualified businesses within 30 miles of the Niagara Power Project. There are also 20 MW of power available to facilities located in Chautauqua County.

Eligible Projects



New development or expansion projects in the concept and planning stages that:

- Demonstrate a long-term commitment to the Region
- Have a minimum of 100 kilowatts of new electric load

Projects must begin within one year of the award and must be completed within three years of the award.
