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Introduction

This Report to the Governor and Legislative Leaders on the ReCharge New York Power Program (“Report”) is submitted by the Economic Development Power Allocation Board (“EDPAB”) and the Power Authority of the State of New York (“Authority” or “NYPA”) pursuant to Economic Development Law § 188-a(h)(1), which provides:

The board, in consultation with the authority, shall submit to the governor, temporary president of the senate, speaker of the assembly, minority leader of the senate and minority leader of the assembly an evaluation of the effectiveness of the recharge New York power program. Such evaluation shall focus on how the program has aided recipients of power allocations, and may include recommendations for how the program can be made more effective, and shall be based, in part, on the relative costs of power for recipients in comparison to the cost of power for non-recipients. Such evaluation shall be submitted by December thirty-first, two thousand fifteen and by December thirty-first every five years thereafter.

RECHARGE NEW YORK POWER PROGRAM

On April 14, 2011, the ReCharge New York (“RNY”) Power Program was signed into law under Chapter 60 (Part CC) of the Laws of 2011 (“Chapter 60”). The primary statutory provisions governing the RNY Power Program are codified in Economic Development Law (“EDL”) § 188-a and Public Authorities Law §1005(13-a). The RNY Power Program replaced the Power for Jobs (“PFJ”) and related programs to provide a more effective incentive for businesses to create jobs and make long term capital investments in New York State.

The RNY Power Program is a statewide economic development power program that consists of 910 megawatts (“MW”) of “RNY Power,” 50% of which is made available from the hydropower resources of NYPA (“RNY Hydropower”), and 50% of which is provided by NYPA from other sources, which may include purchased power, power from NYPA sources (other than the Niagara and Saint Lawrence projects), or other sources (collectively “RNY Market Power”).

The RNY Power Program is administered by NYPA and the EDPAB. Pursuant to Chapter 60, NYPA provides staff services to support EDPAB’s functions. RNY Power is available to large businesses, small businesses and not-for-profit corporations for the purposes of job retention, business expansion and business attraction. Chapter 60 further provides that (1) at least 350 MW of RNY Power be dedicated to facilities within the service territories served by the New York State Electric and Gas, National Grid and Rochester Gas and Electric utility

companies; (2) at least 200 MW of RNY Power be dedicated to the purpose of attracting new businesses and encouraging expansion of existing businesses statewide; and (3) no more than 100 MW be dedicated to not-for-profit corporations and small businesses statewide.

In July 2021, New York legislation revised the RNY Power Program, increasing the low-cost power allocation available to small businesses and non-profit organizations from 100 MW to as much as 150 MW. This reallocation of power allowed more of these eligible entities to access affordable electricity from NYPA.

Under the Program, an “eligible applicant” is defined to mean an eligible business, eligible small business, or eligible not-for-profit corporation. An eligible applicant does not include retail businesses as defined by EDPAB, including, without limitation, sports venues, gaming or entertainment-related establishments or places of overnight accommodations. EDPAB defines a retail business as a business primarily engaged in making retail sales of goods or services to customers who personally visit such facilities to obtain goods or services.

As part of the contractual agreement for the sale of RNY Power, each customer agrees to retain and/or create jobs, invest future capital in its facility, utilize the allocated power and conduct an energy efficiency audit at the facility using the RNY Power allocation within the first five years of the contract term.

Between April 2012 and December 2025, the NYPA Trustees awarded RNY allocations to new program participants on 45 occasions. Beginning in July 2017, existing customers became eligible to apply for a seven-year extension of their existing RNY allocations. In total, RNY Power allocation extensions have been awarded by the Trustees on 25 occasions from October 2018 to December 2025. To date, nearly 460 RNY Power allocation extensions have been approved by the Trustees supporting nearly 303,000 jobs and nearly \$15 billion in capital investment commitments.

Responding to the COVID-19 global pandemic, on March 31, 2020, the NYPA Trustees approved the Economic Development Customer Assistance Program (“EDCAP”), under which eligible RNY Power customers were permitted to defer payment of monthly NYPA billed energy and demand invoices for a period of up to six months without interest or penalty. Deferred amounts were recovered over an 18-month period. More than 300 RNY Power customers participated in EDCAP.

To provide further relief to help customers manage energy costs, NYPA also offered business customers an additional benefit under EDCAP known as Temporary Power Assistance (“TPA”). Under the TPA program, RNY customers were invited

to apply for additional RNY Power to serve the portion of their load that was not served by NYPA. These supplemental allocations did not require additional commitment of jobs or capital investment. At the December 9, 2020 Trustee Meeting, 230 MW of RNY Power was awarded to customers in the initial round of EDCAP TPA approvals. The supplemental power was enrolled for eligible customers as of February 1, 2021 and remained in effect until January 31, 2024.

In addition to the EDCAP initiatives in response to the COVID-19 global pandemic, the NYPA Board of Trustees approved deferrals of the contractual annual compliance action for the following reporting periods: July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019; July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020; and July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021. As a result, no RNY allocations were reduced based on compliance action for those periods. Additionally, for the reporting period from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022, the Board waived any allocation reductions and approved adjustments to job and/or capital investment commitments for customers that failed to achieve at least a 90% compliance rate. These actions were intended to provide flexibility and achieve greater compliance percentages in subsequent reporting periods, as customers tried to recover from the impacts of the pandemic.

RNY POWER PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION

The RNY Power allocation process commences with the filing of an application for both new and extension applicants. The application for RNY Power was incorporated into the State's on-line Consolidated Funding Application ("CFA") and made available to applicants beginning in September 2011. The application remains within the CFA, and the RNY program remains an active open enrollment program with the system, along within other state incentives.

RNY Power applications are reviewed by NYPA staff and presented to EDPAB for eligibility determinations. If an applicant is deemed eligible, EDPAB evaluates the application on its merits based on statutory criteria which include the following:

1. The significance of electricity costs to the applicant;
2. The extent to which a RNY award would result in new capital investments in the State;
3. The extent to which a RNY allocation is consistent with any regional economic development council strategies and priorities;
4. The types of facilities the applicant proposes to construct, enlarge, or install in consideration for a RNY allocation;
5. The payroll, salaries and benefits provided by the applicant;
6. The number of jobs the applicant would create or retain in relation to the size of the RNY allocation requested;

7. The risk the applicant would leave the State, curtail operations, or eliminate jobs without the RNY allocation;
8. The significance of the applicant's facilities to the local economy;
9. The extent to which the applicant has invested in energy efficiency measures, will agree to make tangible investments in energy efficiency measures or participate in energy audits of its facilities;
10. Whether the applicant receives a hydroelectric power allocation or benefits supported by the sale of hydroelectric power under another program administered in whole or part by NYPA;
11. The extent to which a power allocation will result in an advantage as compared to its competitors in the State; and
12. Regarding not-for-profit corporation applicants, whether the applicant provides critical services or substantial benefits to the local community.

The NYPA Trustees make final award decisions after considering EDPAB's recommendations and the statutory criteria. Applications are evaluated using a standardized process that allows flexibility to account for significant or unique projects or other priorities, including projects that align with New York State strategies, support the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act ("CLCPA"), are located in disadvantaged communities, are submitted by minority or women-owned business enterprises ("MWBE") or service-disabled veteran-owned business ("SDVOB"), and/or involve business that supports renewable energy technologies.


On December 9, 2020, the NYPA Trustees authorized the implementation of a "green jobs" incentive plan for NYPA's economic development power programs. Under this plan, businesses participating in NYPA's power programs may receive enhanced evaluation scoring for the creation and retention of green jobs. The green jobs evaluation is applied prospectively to new program participants applying for RNY Power to support new load, as well as to retention-based load that is not currently served by the Authority. The green jobs incentive plan supports the Authority's 2030 Strategic Plan, which encourages the promotion of the clean energy sector. Currently, ReCharge NY is supporting 16 businesses that have created or retained 2,900 green jobs throughout the state.

In alignment with New York State goals, the RNY Power Program places an emphasis on supporting businesses located in disadvantaged communities ("DACs"). On December 7, 2021 the NYPA Trustees determined that businesses in DACs would be given special consideration when applying for an RNY allocation. A business is identified

as being in a DAC based on criteria determined by New York State’s Climate Justice Working Group (“CJWG”). The CJWG, which is comprised of representatives from State Agencies and environmental justice organizations across the State, was formed to identify DACs and ensure that these communities directly benefit from the State’s transition to clean energy. The criteria used in determining DACs include factors such as environmental burdens, climate change risk, population characteristics and health vulnerabilities. As of December 2025, the RNY program has awarded more than 270 MW to nearly 290 businesses and not-for-profit entities located in DACs.

NYPA and EDPAB also receive input on applications from the relevant State Regional Economic Development Councils (“REDCs”) for the region where an applicant’s facilities are or will be located. REDCs were established by state leadership in 2011 to develop long-term strategic priorities and plans for economic growth in their respective regions and are denoted in the map below. In 2025, Governor Hochul announced the launch of the 2025 Regional Economic Development Council Initiative which established the Advancing Collaboration for High-Impact Initiatives for Economic Visions & Expansion (ACHIEVE) competition. The ACHIEVE competition will award \$150 million to support high-impact regional initiatives. Similar to the RNY Power program, applicants apply via the CFA for consideration in the ACHIEVE competition.

RNY POWER CONTRACT PROCESS

To promote long-term business commitments to the State, new and extended RNY Power allocations (“Awarded Allocations”) are generally offered for a term of up to seven years. Each Awarded Allocation consists of equal parts RNY Hydropower and RNY Market Power. To help accommodate the energy needs of new RNY Power awardees, each recipient is given the option to purchase its entire Awarded Allocation (50% RNY Hydropower and 50% RNY Market Power) or just the RNY Hydropower portion of the Awarded Allocation.

The terms and conditions applicable to the sale of the portion of the Awarded Allocation the customer decides to purchase (“Accepted Allocation”) is set forth in a contract between NYPA and the customer (“RNY Contract”). The RNY Contract also includes provisions that:

- Require annual reporting on compliance with contractual commitments relating to such matters as employment, capital investments and power utilization (“Supplemental Commitments”);
- Authorize periodic audits by NYPA to assess compliance with Supplemental Commitments; and
- Provide for the partial or complete withdrawal of RNY Power in the event of noncompliance with Supplemental Commitments.

RNY POWER AWARDS AND AVAILABILITY

Figure 1 below provides a breakdown of the current RNY power allocations statewide. The enactment establishing the Recharge New York Power program contains provisions

indicating the purposes for which RNY Power should be allocated under the program, specifically for expansion power, not-for-profit and small business allotments. There is an additional legislative mandate requiring that at least 350 MW of the 910 MW of RNY Power be dedicated to facilities in the service territories served by the New York State Electric and Gas, National Grid and Rochester Gas and Electric utility companies. Currently, 607.8 MW of the total 877.1 MW of RNY Power allocated has been awarded in these service territories.

As of December 31, 2025, a total of 877.1 MW of RNY Power has been allocated to eligible businesses across the State. This consists of 878 allocations awarded to 762 customers, including 119 not-for-profit corporations and 643 small and large businesses. Small businesses are defined as having a typical monthly electric demand at or below 400 kilowatts (“kW”) while large businesses have a demand above 400 kW. A listing of current RNY Power awards, including recipient name, location, region, amount of power awarded, length of current Accepted Allocation and the number of jobs associated with these allocations is found in **Appendix I** to this Report.

As of December 31, 2025, the RNY Power Program had a balance of 32.9 MW of power available for allocation. Total allocated RNY power consists of over 478 MW for large business retention, nearly 270 MW for large business expansion, and nearly 129 MW for small businesses and not-for-profit corporations.

NYPA’s annual compliance review process may result in the recapture of RNY Power where RNY Power recipients have failed to meet their contractual commitments relating to job, capital investment, and power usage.

¹ This amount of unallocated RNY Power may not be available to all eligible applicants. The underlying statute specifies set-asides and caps on the amount of RNY Power that may be allocated for purposes of business retention and expansion, and certain categories of eligible applicants (e.g., not-for-profit corporations). See Economic Development Law § 188-a(c) (4).

Each year NYPA participates in regional workshops administered by Empire State Development through the CFA funding process, informing the communities of the aspects of the RNY Power Program in public or virtual sessions.

Figure 2 below provides a detailed breakdown of RNY Power allocations across the 10 NYS Economic Development regions, showing job creation and retention along with capital investment commitments. The total number of customers includes large business retention, large business expansion, and small business and not-for-profit entities.

Effectiveness of the RNY Power Program

The effectiveness of the RNY Power Program can be assessed by considering two primary benefits of the program: (1) reduced electricity costs for recipients of RNY Power allocations; and (2) positive economic development impacts for the State, including job retention and job creation and capital investment.

ESTIMATED ELECTRICITY COST BENEFITS

Awarded Allocations are exempt from the State’s Renewable Portfolio Standard surcharge, the Systems Benefit Charge, and the Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standards surcharge (“Delivery Discount”). All RNY customers receive the Delivery Discount, which is not generally available to other electricity consumers in the State. The Delivery Discount applies to the recipient’s total RNY Power allocation even if the RNY Power recipient chooses to purchase only the RNY Hydropower portion of its award from NYPA.

Additional factors affecting the benefit to an RNY Power customer could include:

- Selection of hydropower-only customers vs. blended allocation customers. Some customers have sufficient resources or sizable load to allow them access to potentially less costly or more price-predictable energy sources than market purchases through NYPA. To maximize the benefit to those customers, the option to elect hydropower-only (vs. blended power) is available to RNY allocation recipients.
- Commodity cost for the power if purchased from the investor-owned utility instead of at the RNY Power rate.
- Tariff considerations including size of customer load and eligible delivery class.
- Customer operating characteristics such as load factor, service classification and voltage level.

The estimated cost benefit for each participant is based on a comparison of the cost of RNY Power versus the local utility standard electric tariff rates. The cost of RNY Power reflects

commodity and delivery costs. An estimate was developed for the cost of purchase and delivery of an equivalent amount of power from each customer's local utility at the standard tariff rate. The difference between these two values represents the 2024 estimated benefits. These benefits were provided and communicated to customers enrolled in RNY during the 2024 calendar year.

In 2024, RNY Power collectively provided program participants statewide with an average cost benefit of 24% statewide or over \$90 million, factoring in both electric commodity and delivery benefits.

Effective July 1, 2025, NYPA revised the structure of the RNY Power customers' invoices to better outline customer protections against market volatility. The purpose of this initiative, known as the RNY Rate Unbundling Project, was to provide customers with greater transparency into the various cost components that comprise RNY rates, and to more clearly demonstrate the benefits of participating in the RNY Power Program. Under the prior RNY rate structure, NYPA combined the RNY hydropower rate (the Preservation Power price component) with various monthly forecasted market components, including estimated NYISO costs, estimated capacity costs and forecasted market prices. These costs were reconciled monthly through the Energy Charge Adjustment ("ECA"), on customers' invoices. The ECA was capped each month to protect customers against extreme

market volatility, resulting in interest-free deferred charges. However, invoices did not provide detailed visibility into the underlying cost components, the derivation of the ECA, or the capping mechanism.

The RNY Rate Unbundling Project changed how costs are displayed on customers' monthly invoices by unbundling the rate components and presenting them separately. As a result, customers can now clearly see that NYPA hydropower rates remain competitive and stable each month, while cost fluctuations and volatility are attributable to market components outside NYPA's control. The new methodology also introduced the Billing Stabilization Adjustment ("BSA"), which replaced the ECA monthly capping mechanism. This new methodology further demonstrates NYPA's commitment to helping customers control costs, and interest-free deferred charges are now displayed on monthly invoices.

Overall, the RNY Rate Unbundling Project provides customers with a greater understanding of the advantages of participating in the RNY Power Program and greater insight into how NYPA's hydropower rates and bill stabilization methods benefit them.

Figures 3 and 4 below indicate the total estimated cost benefits in each of the 10 NYS Economic Development Regions.



HYDRO ONLY POWER PARTICIPANTS

The estimated cost benefit for the Hydro-Only RNY participant is derived by comparing what the RNY participant would have paid for the purchase and delivery of its RNY power allocation under the local electric utility’s standard tariff rates with the participant’s RNY tariff rates. This estimate was communicated to Hydro-Only RNY participants, and based on utility service

area, ranged from \$806,000 to \$11.6 million in 2024 for the electricity commodity. In addition, Hydro Only RNY participants received delivery cost surcharge exemptions ranging from \$887,000 to \$10.5 million. The cumulative estimated total benefit realized by Hydro Only RNY participants in 2024 exceeded \$51.7 million and is shown in **Figure 5** below.



BLENDING POWER PARTICIPANTS

The estimated cost benefit for the Blended RNY participant is derived from a comparison of what the RNY participant would have paid for the purchase and delivery of their RNY power allocation based on their local electric utility’s standard tariff rate versus their RNY tariff rates. This estimate was communicated to Blended RNY participants, and based on

utility service area, ranged from \$735,000 to \$20.4 million in 2024 for the electric commodity. In addition, Blended RNY participants also received delivery cost surcharge exemptions ranging from \$250,000 to \$2.4 million in 2024. The cumulative estimated total benefit realized by Blended RNY participants in 2024 amounted to more than \$29 million and is shown in **Figure 6** below.



JOB RETENTION AND CREATION

In addition to providing benefits to RNY Power recipients, the RNY Power Program provides benefits to New York State by supporting the retention of existing jobs and the creation of new jobs. This benefit is achieved through contractual commitments by RNY Power Recipients to (i) retain jobs, (ii) create jobs, or (iii) both retain and create jobs, in exchange for RNY Power. Currently, the RNY Power Program supports commitments for the retention and creation of more than 415,000 jobs statewide. For the contractual annual compliance period from July 2023 to June 2024, RNY Power

customers reported more than 477,000 jobs throughout New York State, representing an aggregate compliance achievement of 131% of the jobs committed under RNY Agreements.

Figure 7 below illustrates the number of jobs supported by RNY Power allocations, including extensions, across each of the 10 New York State regions as of December 31, 2025. Because applicants may receive more than one RNY Power allocation (e.g., to support job retention and job creation, respectively), the allocations, customers and related job commitments are presented below on a regional basis.

CAPITAL INVESTMENT COMMITMENTS

The RNY Power Program also supports capital investment throughout New York State. This benefit is provided through contractual commitments by RNY Power recipients to make long-term investments in facilities using the RNY Power allocations. Customers commit to making these investments within the first five years of their seven-year contract. For the contractual annual compliance period of July 2023 to June

2024, RNY Power customers reported a five-year cumulative capital spending of \$22.4 billion which representing a compliance achievement of 138% of the capital investment committed in the RNY Contracts. Statewide capital investment commitments supported by the RNY Power Program currently total nearly \$49.7 billion as detailed below in **Figures 8 and 9**.



As a statewide program, RNY assists businesses across New York State. **Figure 10** represents the Percentage of the Total Allocations by the NYS Economic Development Regions.



INDUSTRIES SUPPORTED BY RNY POWER ALLOCATIONS

The RNY Power Program supports many major industries throughout New York State. These industries are defined and tracked using the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). Manufacturing constitutes the majority of RNY allocated power, accounting for 74%. The hospital sector supports the largest share of jobs under the RNY Power

Program, with more than 173,000 jobs, representing nearly 42% of the program total.

Other predominant sectors include: educational services, crop production, and computing infrastructure providers, data processing, web hosting, and related services. Below are the top five industries supported by RNY and the percentage of total allocations each sector represents.

Between January 2021 and December 2025, 392 businesses were awarded allocations of RNY power. One of the most sizeable awards is the 140 MW allocation to Micron New York Semiconductor Manufacturing LLC. This allocation was provided for a new facility in Clay, New York (Central New York region), along with a commitment to create more than 2,300 new jobs and make a capital investment exceeding

\$19 billion. Other notable awards were provided to Global Foundries (three awards totaling 45 MWs, with 3,161 jobs committed and nearly \$8.7 billion in capital investment commitments) at its Malta facility, and to International Business Machines Corporation (13 MWs, 1,500 jobs committed, and \$60 million in capital investment committed) at its Poughkeepsie facility.

Summary

NYPA and EDPAB continue to implement the RNY Power Program as an effective economic development tool to retain businesses in New York State, encourage existing businesses to expand their operations, and attract new businesses to foster economic growth. In addition, where feasible, NYPA and EDPAB have sought to preserve and enhance the benefits provided by the RNY Power Program in response to changing conditions (e.g., invoice payment and compliance review deferrals, EDCAP and TPA incentives, green jobs incentive). At the same time, the Program emphasizes support for MWBEs and SDVOBs as well as business growth in DACs, and has increased the amount of dedicated low-cost power allocations for small businesses and non-profit organizations

from 100 MW to as much as 150 MW, allowing more eligible entities to access affordable electricity from NYPA.

The RNY Power Program continues to successfully accomplish its intended goal of providing a state-wide, power-based program that effectively supports the retention and creation of jobs and long-term capital investment throughout New York State. As of December 31, 2025, the RNY Power Program supports (1) the retention of approximately 403,000 jobs, (2) the creation of approximately 12,000 jobs, (3) capital spending of nearly \$49.7 billion, and (4) cost benefits equating to more than \$90 million in 2024.

NYPA and EDPAB look forward to continuing to build upon the success of the RNY Power Program in the years ahead.














