A special highlight is the Start-Up Challenge 2025, where innovative projects in the categories Smart Objects & Smart Solutions, Concept & Strategy, Communication & Documentation and Living & Care will be presented and visitors will choose the first place winner of the audience award on April 10 at 1 p.m. in the ALTENPFLEGE Arena.
