This offering will be complemented by the Start-Up Challenge supported by Home Instead, HEWI and CURA, in which innovative projects in the categories Smart Objects & Smart Solutions, Concept & Strategy, Communication & Documentation and Living & Care will be presented and visitors will select the first place winner of the audience award on April 10 at 1 p.m. in the ALTENPFLEGE Arena.

The winners in the respective categories have already been determined: be2-morrow GmbH won the Concept & Strategy category, Parto GmbH came out on top in Communication & Documentation, Smart Objects & Smart Solutions was won by vrblick UG and INCLUSYS won the Living & Care category.

ALTENPFLEGE Arena: A meeting place full of inspiration and ideas
