# BRAZILIAN PUBLIC SAFETY

*And its numbers*

In total, Brazil has 796,180 professionals who are part of the security forces and they are divided into ten corporations. According to the National Security Forum, in 2023 Brazil spent R\$124.8 billion on the public security function, with R\$101 billion financed by the States and the Federal District and R\$23.8 billion by the federal government. Total spending on security grew by 11.6% compared to the previous year precisely due to the greater volume of state expenses, 12.9% compared to 2022.

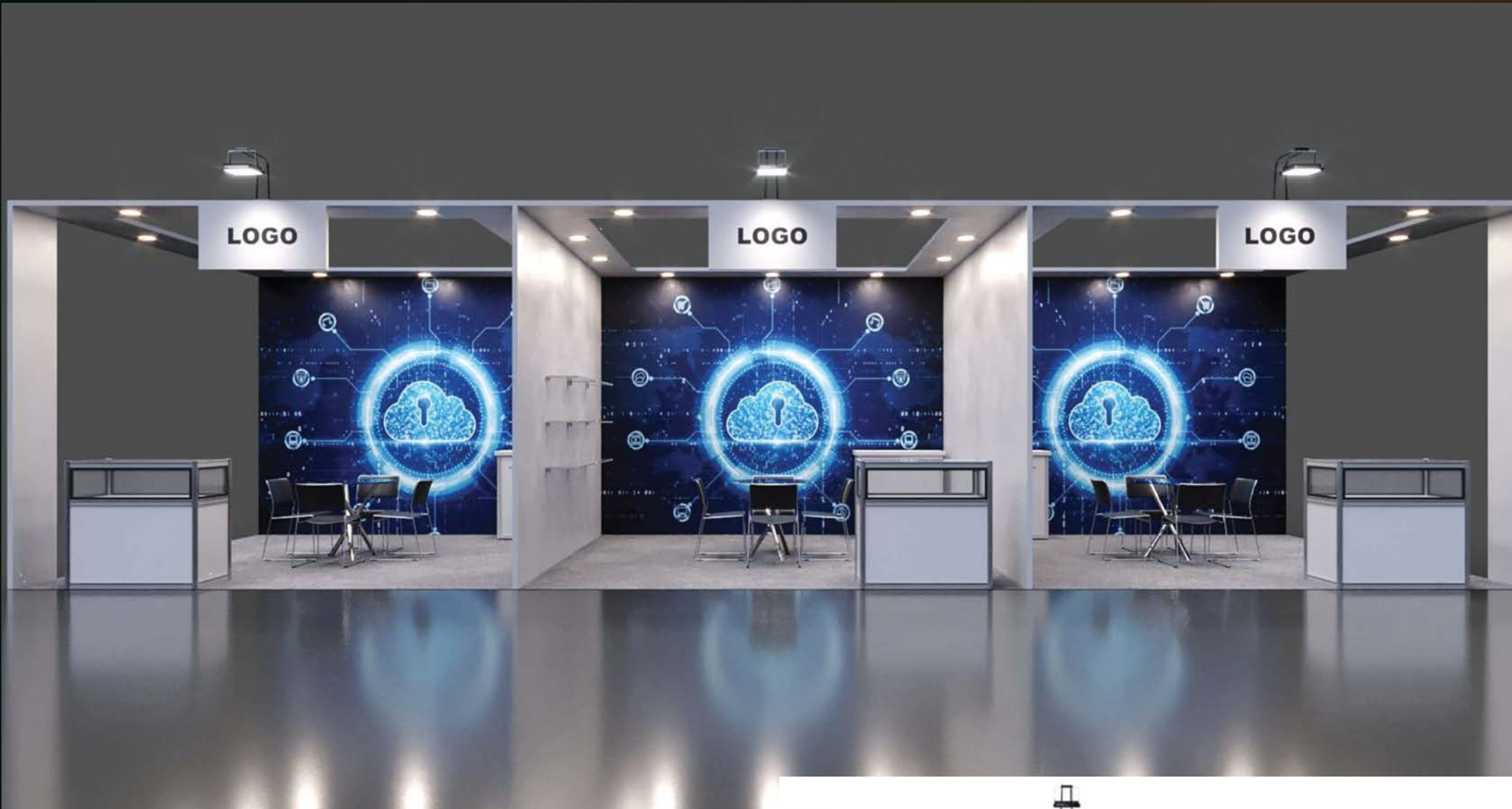

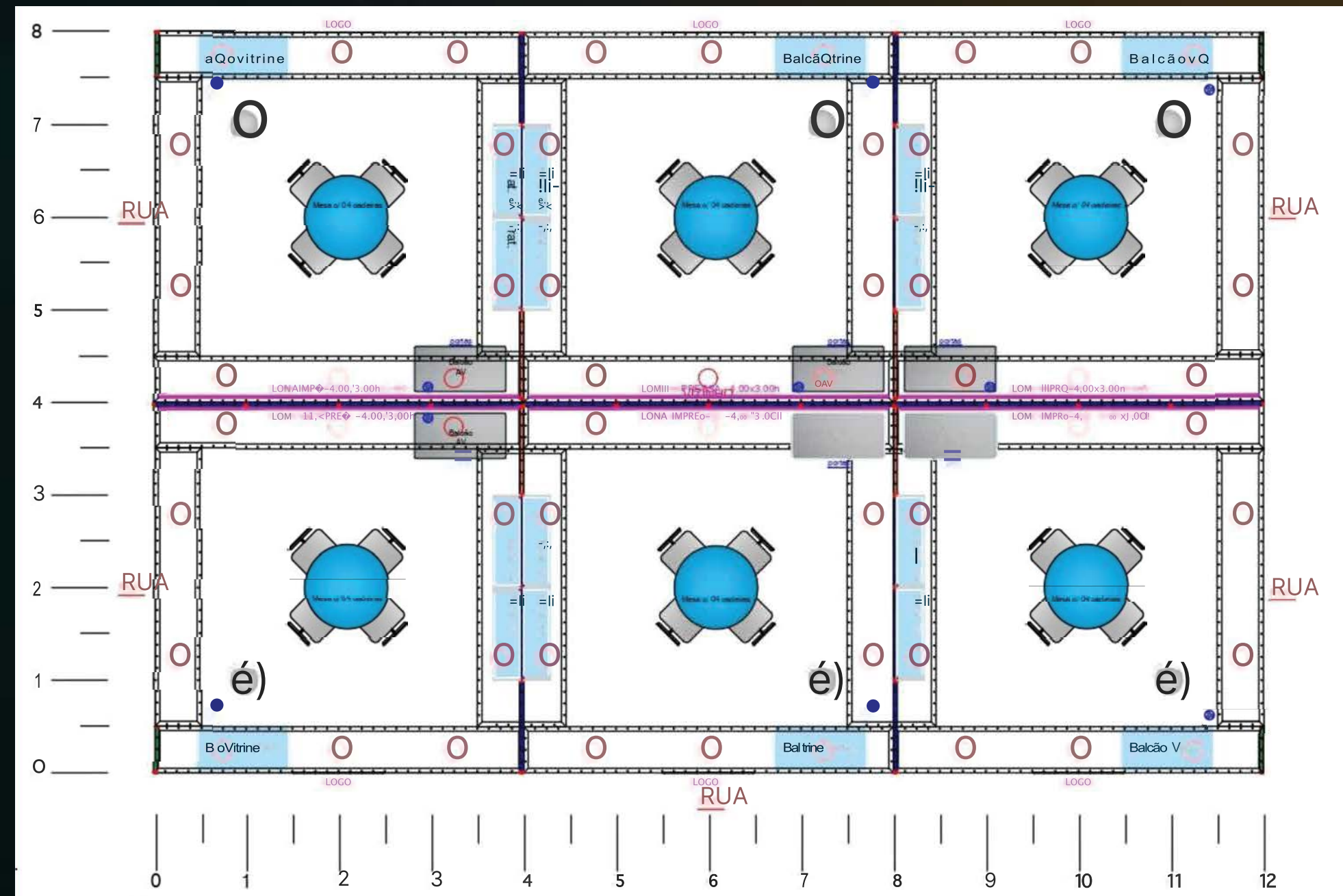
