Members of security agencies and the armed forces are gathering again in Nuremberg on 28 February and 1 March 2023. The tenth anniversary event of the exhibition is larger and more varied than ever. The event is expected to attract about 6,000 visitors in total.

Enforce Tac bridges theory and practice in 2023 with the conference on weapons and protective equipment, where users can learn about new developments in equipment and handling service weapons. The conference is organized by the German Police University, DHPol.
