

Information and formalities for the presentation of live animals at Interzoo

During Interzoo, exhibitors presenting live animals are subject to the provisions of the **German Animal Welfare Act** (<https://www.gesetze-im-internet.de/tierschg/BJNR012770972.html>). In consultation with the competent authorities for the trade fair, the organizer has defined guidelines that must be observed when presenting live animals.

Registration

Exhibitors must always register live animal presentations/demonstrations at their booths with the organizer in advance. The organizer will decide on the approval of the registered animal presentation, including the species, the number of animals and the number and size of the housing facilities (aquaria, terraria or cages) as exclusively registered by the exhibitor. Housing in different or additional housing facilities is not permitted. If the registered animal presentation is rejected by the organizer for objectively justified reasons, the exhibitor will receive written notification.

Inspection of animal welfare and species protection

The presentation of the registered animals will be checked on site by the competent authority, if necessary, by a representative of the species protection authority and the organizer. For **protected animals** (<https://eur-lex.europa.eu/eli/reg/2023/966/oj>), depending on the protection status, the **original documents required by law** ([https://eur-lex.europa.eu/legal-content/EN/TXT/?uri=CELEX:52022XC0811\(01\)](https://eur-lex.europa.eu/legal-content/EN/TXT/?uri=CELEX:52022XC0811(01))) (CITES certificate or certificate of legal origin) have to be kept on site where they can be presented to the species protection authority.

Invasive alien species

Plant and animal species listed on the list of invasive alien species of Union concern, according to [Regulation \(EU\) 1143/2014](http://data.europa.eu/eli/reg/2014/1143/2019-12-14) (<http://data.europa.eu/eli/reg/2014/1143/2019-12-14>), may not be exhibited from the date the ban enters into force. Products contrary to animal welfare

Poisonous and dangerous animal species

In the case of violation of this order, the organizer may request that the animals are removed from the booth and housed in a suitable location at the exhibitor's expense. We apologize for any inconvenience.

Presentation of terrarium invertebrates

For the presentation of invertebrates in terraria, a minimum size of the terrarium has to be provided for the respective animal species. This will be individually checked by the organizer at the time of registration. However, all terraria must have a floor area of at least 20 × 20 cm and suitable ventilation has to be provided.

The climate must be checked at all times with a thermometer and hygrometer. Aquatic terraria have to be provided with an additional thermometer in the water part.

As a matter of principle, care should be taken to ensure that the stocking density is appropriate for the animals.

Depending on the animal species, sufficient opportunities for hiding, climbing and digging must be offered.

All terrariums must be placed at least at table height (min. 60 cm) and reliably secured with suitable methods (e.g., a lock) to prevent unauthorized opening, reaching into the enclosure, or escape of the animals.

Suitable food for the animals presented must be available at the booth at any time. They must be provided with sufficient food throughout the exhibition.

Animals must be in place no later than the official start of the trade fair. The animal stock must not be changed during the trade fair.
