Following the sale of WEKA Fachmedien by its previous owner Paragon, NürnbergMesse will be able to keep this successful ecosystem together and expand it further to address future opportunities.

Embedded systems, which comprise both hardware and software, perform control and instrumentation functions in products like driver assist systems, CNC controls, and smart home appliances.
