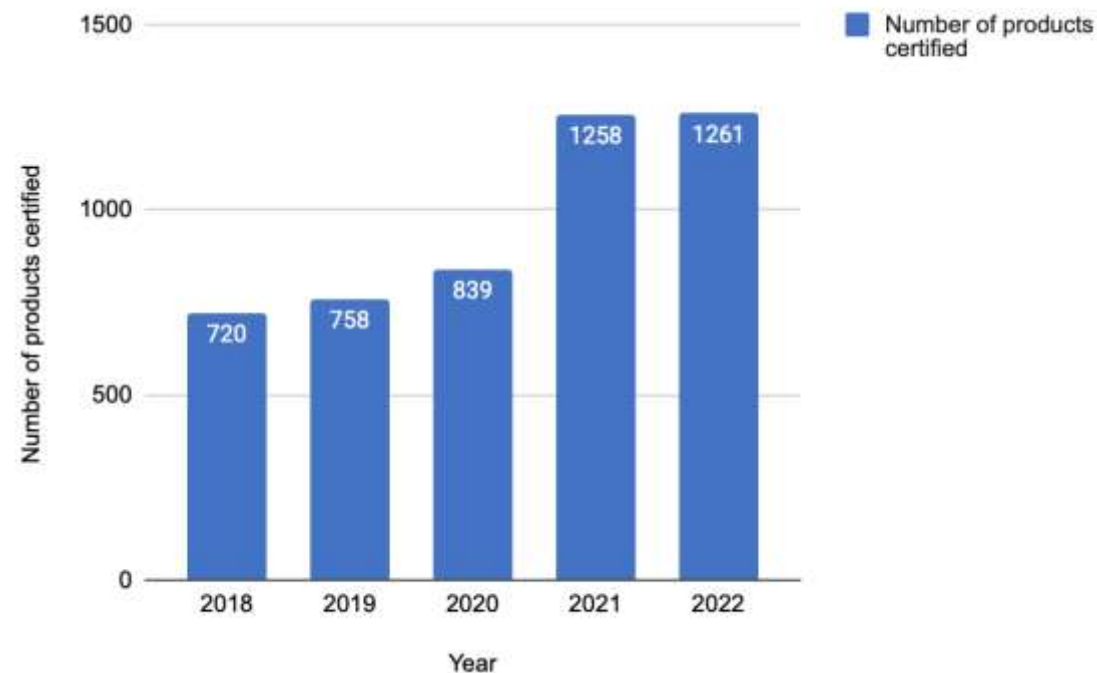

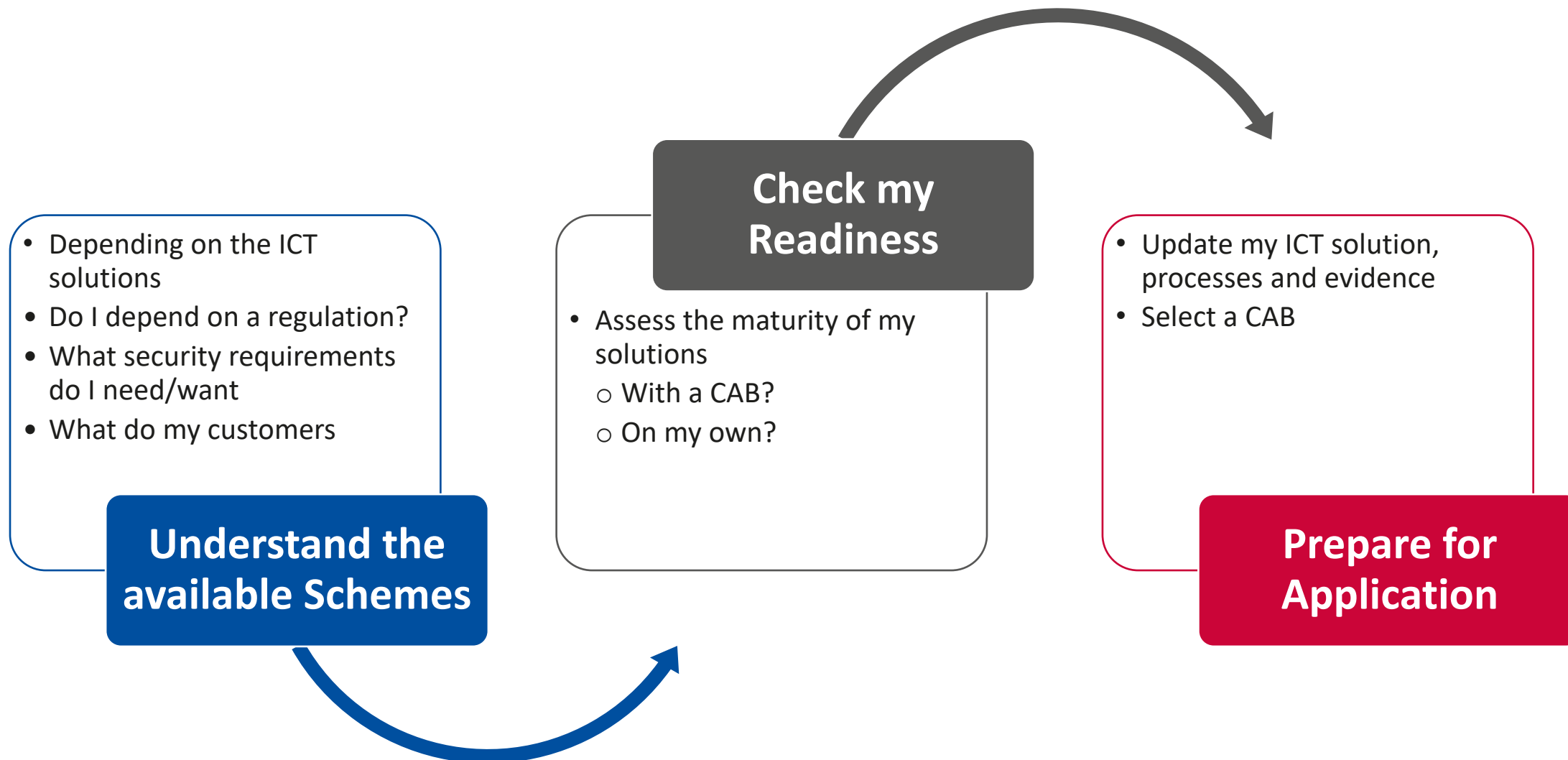
CERTIFICATION AS A ENABLER OF BUSINESS

- General **Increase of certification** in the past couples of year
- Linked to the creation of **new assessment schemes** (IoT, sectoral schemes – mobility)
- Around 300 assessment bodies worldwide (labs, evaluators, auditors, licensed CABs,..)

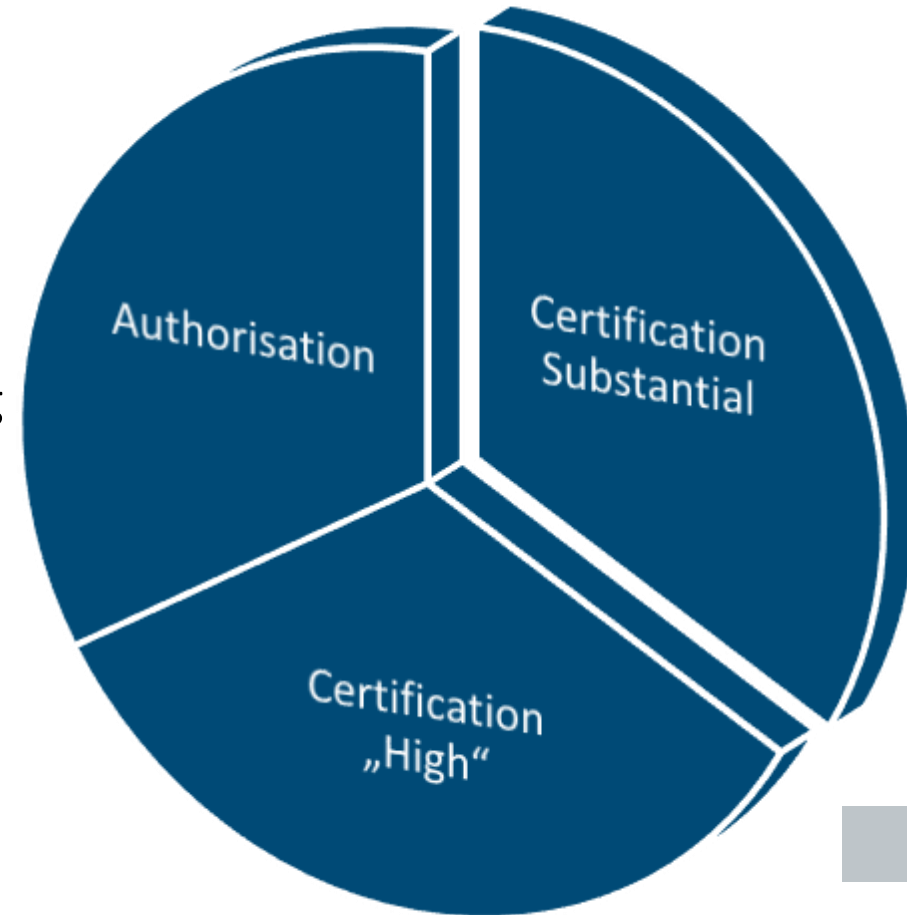
BSI at your Service
