A Year in Review**



Opened COVID-19 Testing & Laboratory Sites


- Collaborated with over a dozen NYC agencies to open 31 COVID laboratories and testing centers within weeks.



Getting Back to Work

- In March, we stopped work on roughly 670 projects.
- In multiple phases beginning in late spring, we were able to resume work.
- Environmental & Regulatory Compliance reviewed every contractor's safety plan prior to restarting to ensure compliance with NYS guidelines and conducting spot inspections for compliance of the guidelines to safely restart our work.

I. PEOPLE

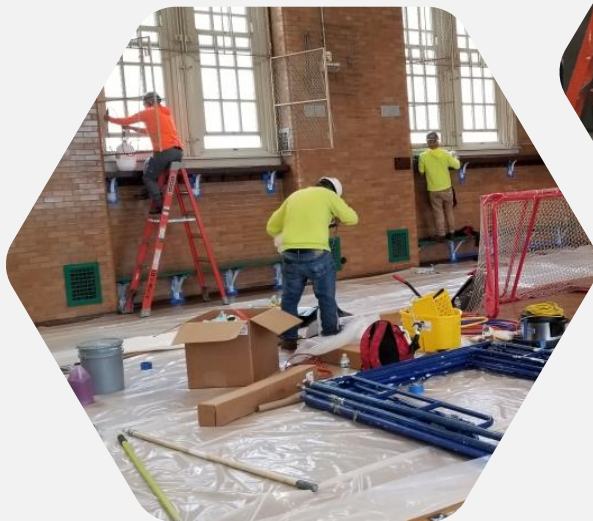
A. Physical Distancing. To ensure employees comply with physical distancing requirements, you agree that you will do the following:

- Ensure 6 ft. distance between personnel, unless safety or core function of the work activity requires a shorter distance. Any time personnel are less than 6 ft. apart from one another, personnel must wear acceptable face coverings.
- Tightly confined spaces will be occupied by only one individual at a time, unless all occupants are wearing face coverings. If occupied by more than one person, will keep occupancy under 50% of maximum capacity.

Lead Remediation Work

- In June, we were able to restart our Lead Paint remediation program and by mid-November, we completed testing and remediation of over 11,000 rooms in almost 900 buildings as part of the gymnasium and bathroom phase of work.



Air Conditioning Initiative

- In June, the SCA resumed the Air Conditioning Initiative electrical work and assumed the responsibility of installing the air conditioning units.
- By the end of 2020, the SCA completed the electrical work and installation of roughly 2,000 units.
- Upon the completion of the A/C Initiative, roughly 20,000 air conditioning units will be installed in classrooms along with supporting electrical work in 704 school buildings throughout New York City.



Exceeding MWLBE Goals

- In FY 2020, MWLBE firms were awarded over \$143 million in prime contracts and over \$386 million in sub-contracts reaching a 34% participation rate and exceeding the City's MWLBE goal.
- Business Development staff assisted Mentor firms in securing 37 Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) awards totaling over \$3.2 million dollars.
- When projects were restarted, Mentor firms were provided with training on new COVID-19 Safety protocols.
- Hosted and attended numerous workshops and forums to educate the public and recruit firms.

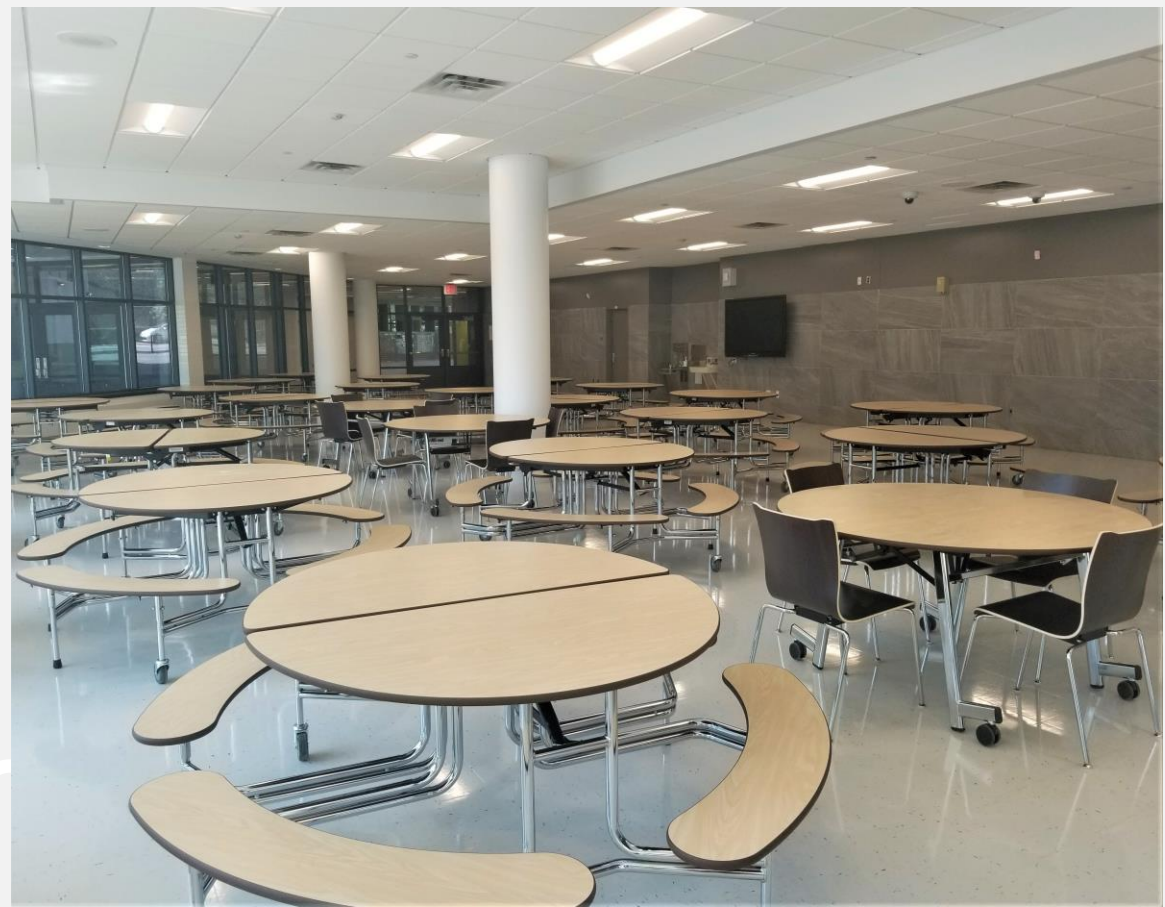
12 New Buildings/Additions & 10 3-K

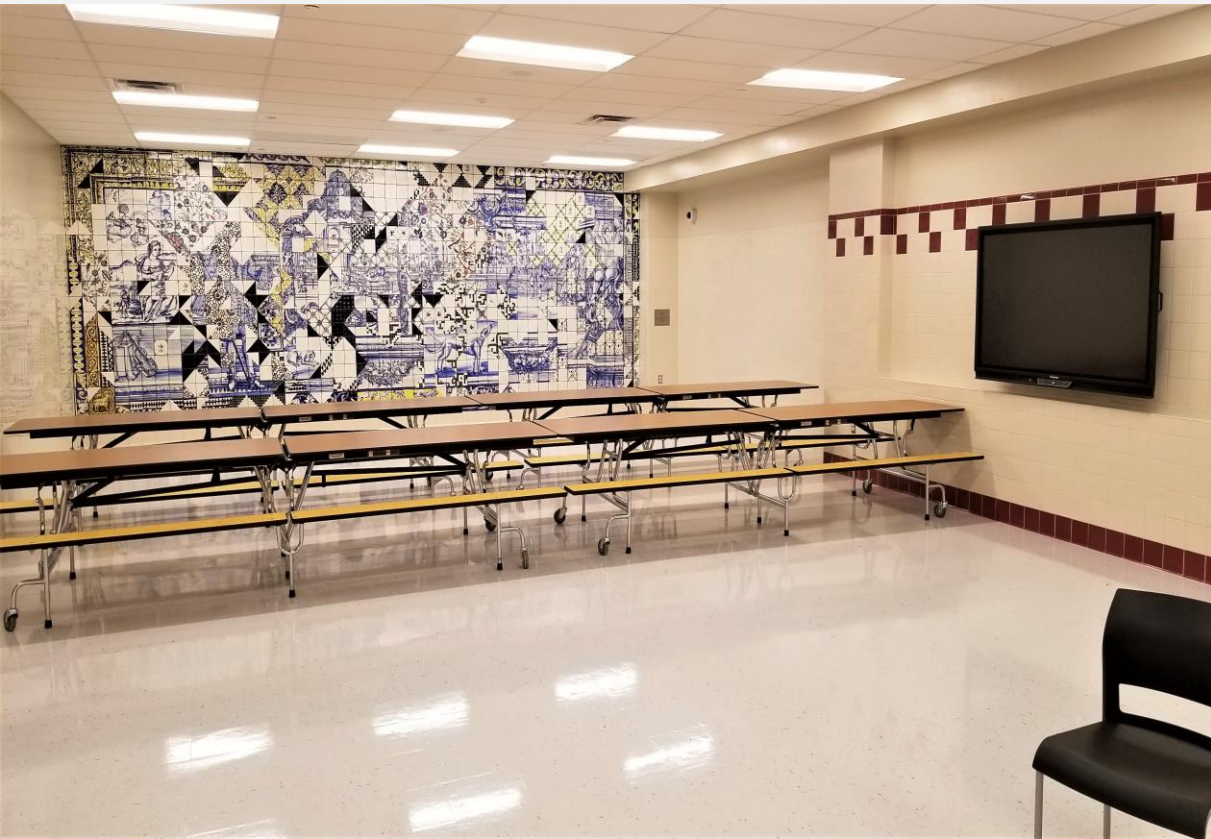
