

**AMENDMENT TO  
LETTER OF RESOLUTION**

**Between the  
The New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and  
Historic Preservation,  
and  
The New York City School Construction Authority on  
behalf of the New York City Department of Education**

**WHEREAS**, the *Letter of Resolution (the LOR) between the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP) and the New York City School Construction Authority (SCA)* was executed on July 24, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the New York City Department of Education (DOE) may fund or grant approval for projects with the potential to impact buildings, structures, objects, or sites listed or eligible for listing in the State Register of Historic Places (State Register), and;

**WHEREAS**, the SCA and OPRHP find benefit in establishing alternate procedures to implement Section 14.09 in a manner that will expedite the review of projects by identifying categories of resources that do not meet the criteria for inclusion in the State Register and by specifying categories of proposed actions that do not have the potential to adversely Impact Historic Resources;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in accordance with Section 8 “Amendment” of the LOR, the SCA and SHPO agree to amend Appendix A to the LOR to add Section VI, which will exempt from review certain site work that allows for temporary installations during ongoing work as follows:

**VI. Temporary Installations During Ongoing Work**

- Temporary installations to allow for safe and code compliant work to be performed, provided that upon completion, items will be returned to their original condition by reinstalling the original materials or with materials that are in-kind to “match” existing historic elements. Masonry units requiring replacement shall meet the requirements of the specification in Appendix B. No saw-cutting of exposed masonry will be proposed or permitted, exposed masonry components will be removed to the existing joints.
- Temporary Egress Work to ensure uninterrupted, code-compliant life safety measures, which involve creating an opening in an exterior wall (or modifying an existing window)

for a door and installing temporary egress stairs or ramp. Once the temporary egress is no longer required, the temporary stair or ramp will be removed and the wall and/or window are reinstalled with the original materials or with an in-kind replacement to "match" the original materials. Masonry units requiring replacement shall meet the requirements of the specification in Appendix B. No saw-cutting of exposed masonry will be proposed or permitted, exposed masonry components will be removed to the existing joints.
