RE: Longhorn Mitigation Plan (LMP) Changes

Dear Mr. Materna:

PHMSA Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS) Central Region has received your letter dated, June 2, 2020, regarding proposed changes in the capacity of the Longhorn Pipeline (Longhorn) refined products system from Odessa to El Paso. Item 31 of the Longhorn Mitigation Plan (LMP) commitments includes performance of a surge pressure analysis for proposed capacity increases. Magellan Midstream Partners, L.P. (Magellan) provided the results of a surge pressure analysis modeling the proposed increased flowrate and the mitigation measures to prevent pressure excursions above allowable limits.

Based on a review of the information provided, the identified mitigation measures address the operational scenarios modeled in the surge analysis at the proposed increased capacity. Therefore, the identified surge pressure mitigation measures are acceptable to OPS Central Region. Furthermore, OPS Central Region concurs with updating the Longhorn Mitigation Plan's description of the Odessa to El Paso refined products system capacities.
