No. 161.51.0 (including supplements thereto and reissues thereof)~~; (b) for Origin of Flint Hills Resources, L.P., Pine Bend, Dakota County, MN, the joint tariff rate charged by Carrier, in conjunction with participating carrier KPL Northern States, LLC, for transportation of Petroleum Products to the Destinations established in **[W]** Carrier’s ~~Tariff currently effective F.E.R.C. Any such movement permitted by Carrier from Carrier’s origins defined in Item 200 of **[W]** Carrier’s ~~Tariff currently effective F.E.R.C. No. 161.51.0 (including supplements thereto and reissues thereof)~~ will have reserved capacity only on the route from Frost, Texas to the **[W]** El Paso (MPL), TX area Destinations.
