Note 2: “Base Rate” means for Origins of Galena Park, TX; East Houston, TX; or Pasadena (MVP), TX, the local, uncommitted rate charged by Carrier for transportation of Petroleum Products from the Origins to the Destinations established in Carrier’s Tariff F.E.R.C. No. 161.55.0 (including supplements thereto and reissues thereof).

Note 3: Deliveries of jet fuel, Arizona grade product, or NEP grade product to any Destination require segregated storage pursuant to a separate written agreement at facilities designated by Carrier.

Note 4: Movements from Carrier’s origins defined in Item 200 of Carrier’s Tariff F.E.R.C. No. 161.55.0 (including supplements thereto and reissues thereof) are considered by Carrier as a reversal of the normal product flow and will only be made upon request and upon Carrier’s determination that such movement can operationally and efficiently be made. Any such movement permitted by Carrier from Carrier’s origins defined in Item 200 of Carrier’s Tariff F.E.R.C. No. 161.55.0 (including supplements thereto and reissues thereof) will have reserved capacity only on the route from Frost, Texas to the Destinations.
