On December 27, 2024, Guardian Pipeline, L.L.C. filed tariff records<sup>1</sup> to reflect administrative updates and the removal of an expired agreement. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Pipeline Regulation, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the tariff records are accepted, effective February 3, 2025, as requested.

The filing was publicly noticed. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted.

This action shall not be construed as a waiver of the requirements of section 7 of the Natural Gas Act, as amended; nor shall it be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in the applicant's tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the applicant.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.

Pursuant to section 4 of the Natural Gas Act and Part 154 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") regulations, Guardian Pipeline, L.L.C. ("Guardian") respectfully submits for filing and acceptance the tariff records listed below as part of its FERC Gas Tariff, Volume No. 1A ("Tariff"). The following proposed tariff records are submitted to become effective February 3, 2025.

### **Statement of Nature, Reasons and Basis for the Proposed Changes**

Guardian submits this administrative filing to reconcile recent updates made to Part 2.0 of its Tariff. On November 22, 2024,<sup>1</sup> Guardian submitted Summary of Agreements, v. 89.0.0, to be effective November 21, 2024. The Commission approved this filing by Letter Order on December 12, 2024. On November 26, 2024,<sup>2</sup> Guardian submitted an additional change affecting the Summary of Agreements. In the filing, Guardian noted that because the requested effective date of the proposed v. 90.0.0 preceded v. 89.0.0, Guardian would make this administrative filing. The Commission approved the second filing by Letter Order December 17, 2024.

Guardian is further providing notice of the termination of a negotiated rate parking and lending (“PAL”) agreement on file with the Commission in compliance with section 154.602 of the Commission’s regulations. No customers were adversely affected by the termination of this service agreement, which expired on its own terms. Guardian submits tariff record changes to Part 2.0, Summary of Agreements, as noted above, to remove the following PAL agreement:

Guardian has not identified any waivers of the Commission’s regulations needed to permit its filing to become effective as proposed; however, Guardian respectfully requests that, should the Commission determine that any such waivers are required, the Commission grant such waivers as are necessary in order that the revised tariff records may be made effective as proposed. No waiver of Guardian’s Tariff is herein requested.
