Guardian Pipeline, L.L.C.

On October 18, 2024, Guardian Pipeline, L.L.C. filed a revised tariff record¹ to remove certain non-conforming agreements which have expired or have been amended and extended as conforming agreements. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Pipeline Regulation, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the tariff record is accepted, effective November 20, 2024, as requested.

The filing was publicly noticed. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted.

This action shall not be construed as a waiver of the requirements of section 7 of the Natural Gas Act, as amended; nor shall it be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in the applicant's tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the applicant.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.

Pursuant to Section 4 of the Natural Gas Act and Part 154 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) Regulations, Guardian Pipeline, L.L.C. (“Guardian”) respectfully submits for filing and acceptance the tariff records listed below as part of its FERC Gas Tariff, Volume No. 1 (“Tariff”). The proposed Tariff revisions are submitted to become effective November 20, 2024:

Part 8.0, Section 38, Non-Conforming Agreements, v. 5.0.0

Statement of Nature, Reasons, and Basis for Proposed Change

In compliance with section 154.602¹ of the Commission’s regulations, Guardian proposes to remove from Part 8.0, Section 38 of its Tariff, Volume 1, certain non-conforming agreements that will expire as of October 31, 2024 or have been amended and extended as fully conforming agreements as of November 1, 2024.²

Guardian seeks a waiver of the 30-day notice requirement for removing the service agreements listed below. No customers were adversely affected by the proposed changes to these service agreements. Guardian submits tariff record changes, as noted above, to remove the following non-conforming agreements:

Additionally, in compliance with section 154.602 of the Commission’s regulations, Guardian proposes to remove from Part 8, Section 38 of its Tariff, Volume 1, reference to certain previously non-conforming agreements that have been amended as fully conforming and previously were approved for removal from Guardian’s Tariff, Volume 1A under Docket No. RP23-591-000.³ Due to an administrative oversight, two previously non-conforming service agreements referenced in Part 8, Section 38 of Tariff, Volume 1 were not concurrently submitted for removal at the time of Guardian’s filing in RP23-591-000. Therefore, Guardian now submits tariff record changes to remove:

Pursuant to section 154.7(a)(7) of the Commission’s regulations, Guardian respectfully requests that the Commission grant a waiver to its 30-day notice of cancellation requirement found in section 154.602 of the Commission’s regulations. Guardian has not identified any additional waivers of the Commission’s Regulations needed to permit this filing to become effective as proposed; however, Guardian respectfully requests that, should the Commission determine that any such waivers are required, the Commission grant such waivers as are necessary in order that the revised tariff records may be made effective as proposed. No waiver of Guardian’s Tariff is herein requested.
