

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

- The following legal entities including tribal affiliations in communities where ONEOK operates:
 - Fire Department
 - Police Department
 - Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
 - Emergency Management
 - Emergency Communication

GRANT ELIGIBILITY

- Eligible items:
 - Fire, safety and medical equipment
 - Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) or Gear
 - Communication Equipment or System
- Applicants may apply and receive one grant per year.
- Grant awards are generally \$5,000 or less and designated for specific items requested.
- Recipients must submit all requested documentation, including tax-exempt status, to qualify for a grant and are expected to complete a receipt of the grant upon payment.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Use this link <https://www.cybergrants.com/oneok/emergencyresponder> to create an organization profile account and submit an application.
- If the organization is a 501(c)3, you can create a FrontDoor account then click “Get Started,” which is free and creates a single account/profile to manage and gain access to ONEOK’s portal along with other funders. If the organization is NOT a 501(c)3 or if you don’t want to use FrontDoor, then create an account through “Standard Login” and then click “First time user – create an account.”
- Submit an application by clicking on “Start a New Emergency Responder Grant Application” at the bottom of the Welcome Page.
- Requests are reviewed on a competitive basis.
