Safety Grants Overview



ONEOK's safety grants invest in the well-being of the community and its citizens by meeting essential needs, building resilience through safety and preparedness, and restoring public and natural spaces through engagement and stewardship.

Grant Goals

- Strengthen community resources and promote self-sufficiency by addressing essential needs and providing development and engagement opportunities for the community and its citizens
- Invest in safety education, resources and training that prepare response to natural disasters, personal or public safety, crises intervention and other emergencies
- Restore public spaces and natural habitats by investing in community spaces and engaging in environmental stewardship to restore or minimize impact

Eligibility

Priority is Given to Programs and Projects That:

- Align with ONEOK Foundation Guidelines
- Have clearly defined goals and measurable outcomes
- Use data analytics, proven best practices and innovation for sustainable short and long-term solutions
- Increase access to resources and build capacity to empower individuals and the community well-being
- Collaborate to build long-term impact through a continuum of services and integrated support network
- Create opportunities that may be scaled and/or replicated

Generally Supported vs. Not Supported Initiatives

Organizations and Initiatives Generally Supported:

- Programs and projects serving communities in ONEOK's footprint that align with grant guidelines, focus areas and company values
- Serve the community at large and/or doesn't have specific requirements that might exclude programs or services for certain individuals
- Registered nonprofit organizations exempt from income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section (IRC) 501(c)(3)
- State, local or tribal government entity providing services to the community
- Public schools, districts and foundations
- Post-secondary technical programs, trade schools, colleges and universities

Organizations and Initiatives Generally Not Supported:

- Churches or religious organizations and activities
- Preschool, early childhood and/or childcare programs
- Private, religious and charter schools
- Booster clubs, parent organizations, athletics, teams and extracurricular clubs
- For-profit organizations
- Fundraisers, galas, tournaments, conferences, competitions, travel, teams, team uniforms, athletic fields and sponsorships
