

Skilled Nursing Facility Workforce Quality Incentive Program

What is the Skilled Nursing Facility Workforce Quality Incentive Program?

The Skilled Nursing Facility Workforce Quality Incentive Program (SNF WQIP) is a Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) initiative that provides financial incentives to skilled nursing facilities (SNFs) that meet workforce and quality related performance benchmarks. The program aims to improve resident care through better staffing retention, workforce development, and service quality. Incentive payments are distributed by Medi-Cal managed care plans, including Partnership HealthPlan of California, and are based on an annual performance year evaluation. **Based on the state of California's Enacted Budget for State Fiscal Year 2025-26, the SNF WQIP ended on December 31, 2025.**

Program Eligibility

To be eligible for SNF WQIP:

- The facility must be a freestanding SNF Level B or adult freestanding subacute facility Level B.
- The facility must have an active contract with Partnership under a network provider agreement for the period in which services were rendered to Partnership members.
- Per Medi-Cal program rules, facilities with certain citations or those designated as excluded facility types are **not** eligible.

Exclusions

The following are excluded from SNF WQIP:

- Freestanding pediatric subacute care facilities.
- Intermediate care facilities for the developmentally disabled.
- Distinct part SNFs.
- SNFs with 100% designated special treatment program beds.
- Facilities with one or more Class AA or Class A citations from CDPH during the performance year.
 - If citations are under appeal, payments will be withheld until a final decision is made.

Payment Distribution

DHCS will calculate each SNF WQIP-eligible network provider's performance metrics (Medi-Cal Accountability Set, or MCAS).

SNF WQIP payments will be made by Partnership to SNF WQIP-eligible network providers based on an interim and final per diem amount calculated by DHCS. For each physical year, DHCS will aim to calculate quality scores and provide payment exhibits directing Partnership to pay the interim per diem amount during the first part of the calendar year (CY) following the rating period, and the final per diem amount during the second part of the CY following the rating period.

Partnership is responsible for calculating the number of SNF WQIP qualifying bed days and paying the

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directed per diem amount for all clean claims for SNF WQIP qualifying bed days without regard to when these bed days are reported to DHCS.

Partnership will be netting out any interim amount from the final payment. Partnership will be recouping or withholding any amounts related to Class AA or A citations from interim and final payments as directed by DHCS.

Partnership will make payments to SNF WQIP-eligible network providers for qualifying bed days within 45 calendar days of receiving payment exhibits from DHCS or within 30 calendar days of receiving a clean claim from the provider, whichever is later.

How to Determine Responsible Payer

To determine if Partnership is the responsible payer:

- Verify the member's Medi-Cal managed care enrollment with Partnership.
- Confirm the SNF is in-network with Partnership.
