

## What are Community Supports?

Community Supports (CS) are services provided by Medi-Cal managed care plans that aim to address health-related social needs of Medi-Cal members to help them live healthier lives. Members may receive a CS service if they meet the eligibility criteria and Partnership determines the service is medically appropriate and a cost-effective alternative to services covered under Medi-Cal. CS services, such as Short-Term Post Hospitalization Housing, recuperative care, and/or medically tailored meals, may be helpful interventions for hospital discharge.



- Partnership currently offers the following CS services:

- Housing transition navigation services
- Housing deposits
- Housing tenancy and sustaining services
- Sobering centers
- Short-Term Post Hospitalization Housing
- Recuperative care
- Day habilitation
- Medically tailored meals
- Personal care / homemaker services
- Respite service

*Please note: These services may not be available in all counties, depending upon whether there are providers contracted to provide the service in the county.*
