355 members enrolled with CS Providers, and 384 members enrolled with ECM providers.

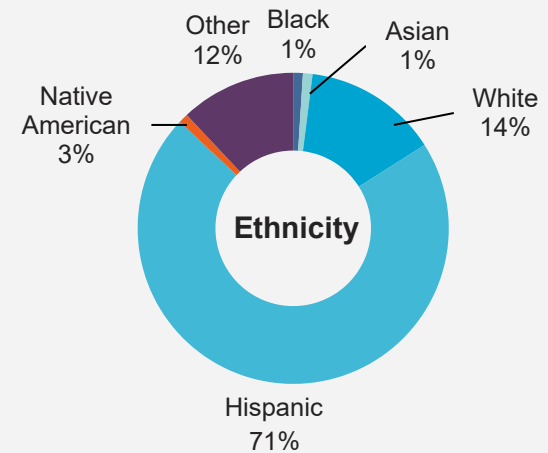
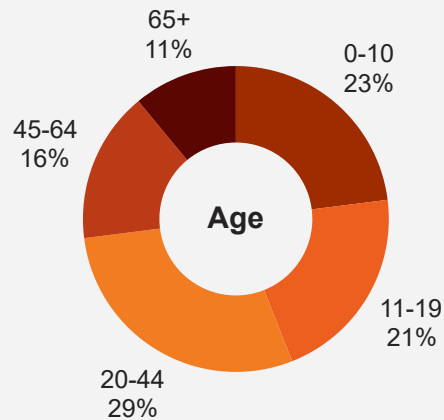


Top three CS services provided – Housing Transition and Navigation Services, Medically Tailored Meals, and Housing Tenancy

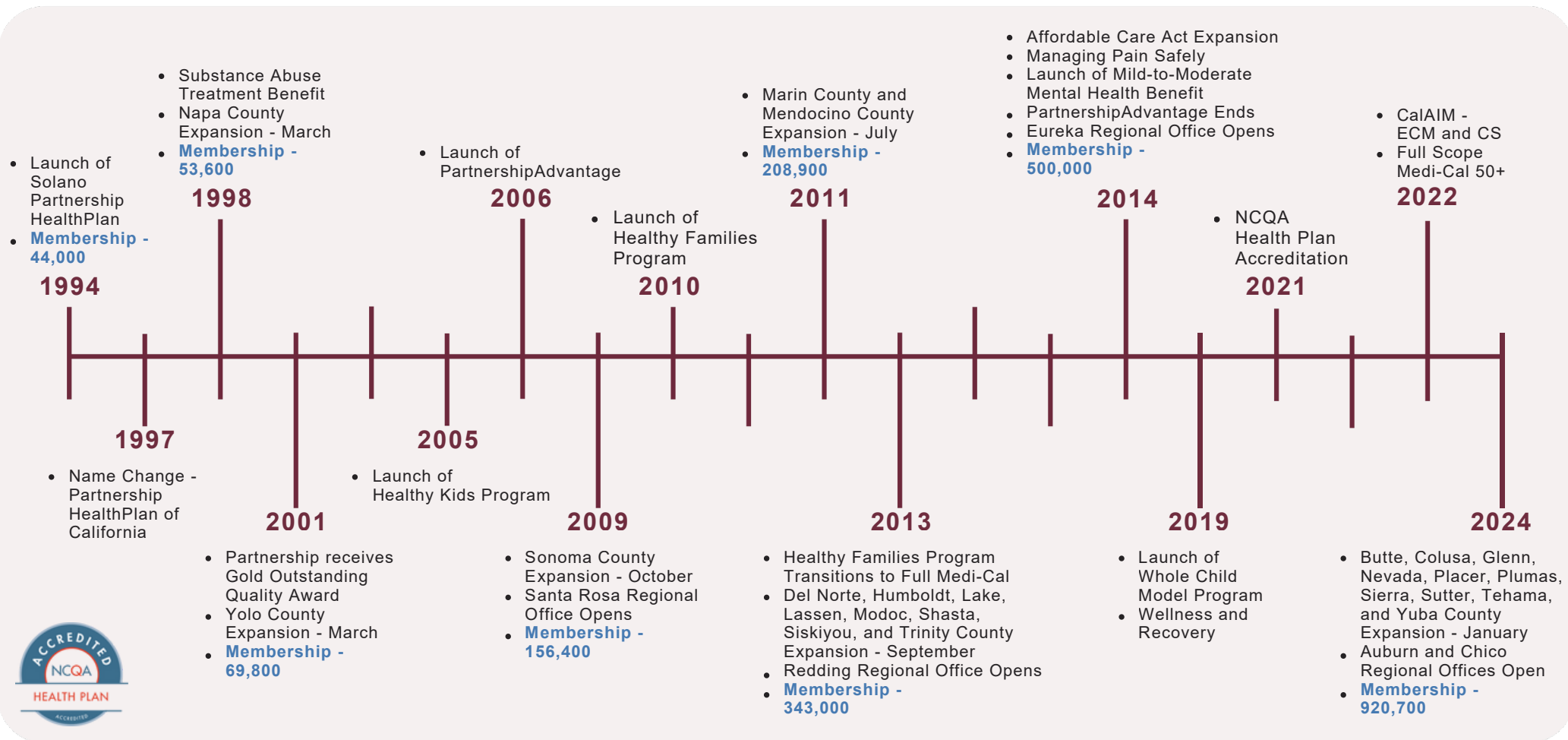
