PERINATAL SUPPORT GROUPS

Moving Beyond Depression Program

“A free, in-home cognitive behavioral therapy program for Nevada County parents who are experiencing depression during or after pregnancy. The family must be enrolled in one of the local home visiting programs to participate in Moving Beyond Depression. Parents in Moving Beyond Depression will receive 15 weekly sessions and a one month follow-up booster session from a licensed therapist. If you are interested in the program, talk to your home visitor. If you are not a home visiting client but are interested in Moving Beyond Depression, contact the MCAH program.”
