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Partnership Hosts Spring Maternity Photoshoot to Support Expectant Members in Solano County

April 17 event connects families to perinatal resources, community support, and maternal health services

FAIRFIELD – Partnership HealthPlan of California is hosting a Spring Maternity Photoshoot on Friday, April 17, 2026, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., offering a family-centered event designed to support maternal health and strengthen connections to local resources.

The free event for expecting Partnership members in Solano County includes professional maternity photos, snacks and beverages, a prize raffle, and on-site access to a network of maternal and early childhood service providers. Expecting parents can also learn about perinatal benefits, doula services, mental health resources, and Partnership’s Growing Together incentive program. Partnership is the Medi-Cal managed care plan in 24 Northern California counties, including Solano County

“Our goal is to create a welcoming and supportive space where pregnant members feel appreciated while also learning about the benefits and services available to them,” said DeLorean Ruffin, DrPH, Partnership’s director of Population Health Management. “For some families, this is a chance to capture a photo they might not otherwise be able to afford while also building connections that are essential throughout pregnancy and the postpartum period.”

The event is part of an ongoing maternal engagement initiative designed to improve prenatal and postpartum experiences for Medi-Cal members, strengthen access to social support, and ensure families are connected to the right services at the right time.

Through conversations, surveys, and partner engagement, Partnership gathers feedback that helps identify gaps in care and guide improvements in maternal health programs across the county.

This spring event is powered by a network of community partners, including Solano WIC, First 5 Solano, Child Start, CommuniCare+OLE, and Solano HEALS doulas, all of whom play a key role in supporting pregnant and postpartum families.

“We truly value the organic conversations that happen at events like this,” Ruffin said. “Those moments often spark insights and connections that support families in ways that can’t always be captured in a clinic visit.”

The April event marks the next phase of Partnership’s growing maternal engagement model, which includes multiple photoshoot events each year and a commitment to expand to additional counties in the future. Each event helps strengthen partnerships, streamline referrals, and build community trust, all key components in improving maternal health outcomes across Solano County and Northern California.
