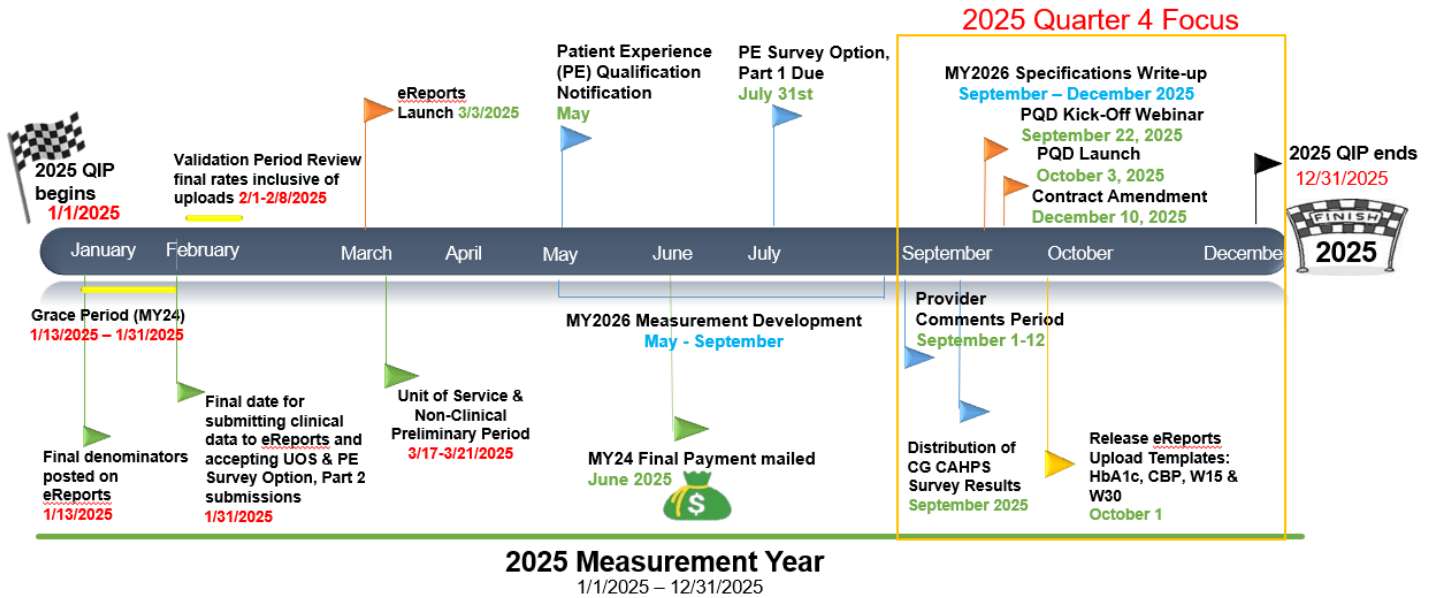
Important Program Reminders and Updates:

- **Annual Contract Amendment for Pay-for-Performance Participation** – As of January 1, 2026, federal law 42 CFR 438.3(i)(3) requires all network providers participating in pay-for-performance (P4P) programs to sign an agreement that includes specific details about the program. To ensure compliance, Partnership’s Contracting Department will be sending your organization a contract amendment electronically via DocuSign and by mail. **Please review, sign, and return this amendment by December 10, 2025.**

- **Partnership’s new core claims system, HealthRules Payer (HRP)** has been delayed. *A new launch date is pending.*
- **2025 Partnership Quality Dashboard (PQD)** was launched on October 3, 2025 and can be viewed within the eReports platform.

- **Electronic Clinical Data Systems is a Unit of Service measure**
Agreements signed after September 30, 2025 will qualify for a half payment of \$1,000, which will be available until December 31, 2025. These data agreements do not have a fixed term, and there is no requirement for contract renewal.

- **New MY2026 PCP QIP Abridged Specifications Manual** will be available on our website as of December 31, 2025.
- **MY2025 Non-Clinical, Patient Experience Measure:** Clinician & Group Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (CG-CAHPS) results were emailed out to qualifying providers on Friday, September 12, 2025. For providers who did not qualify for CG-CAHPS, **Survey Option part 2 is due by January 30, 2026**
- **Clinical Exclusions** are currently being accepted through January 30, 2026.
- **Small Denominator Exclusions** can be submitted between January 15 - 30, 2026 for all PCP QIP providers
- **Unit of Service (UOS)** – templates for UOS measures: Patient-Centered Medical Home Recognition, Peer-led Self-Management Support Group, Health Information Exchange (HIE), and Health Equity Implementation Plan are **all due by January 30, 2026**.
