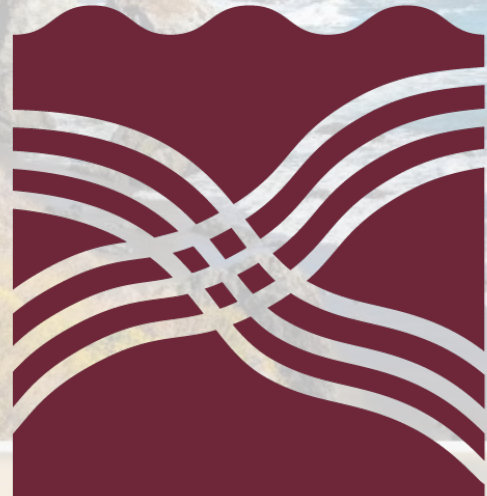

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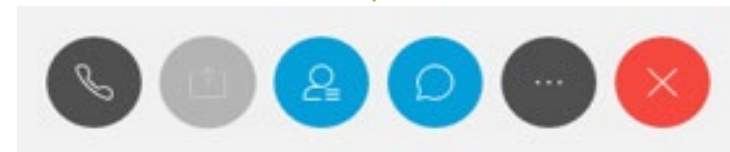
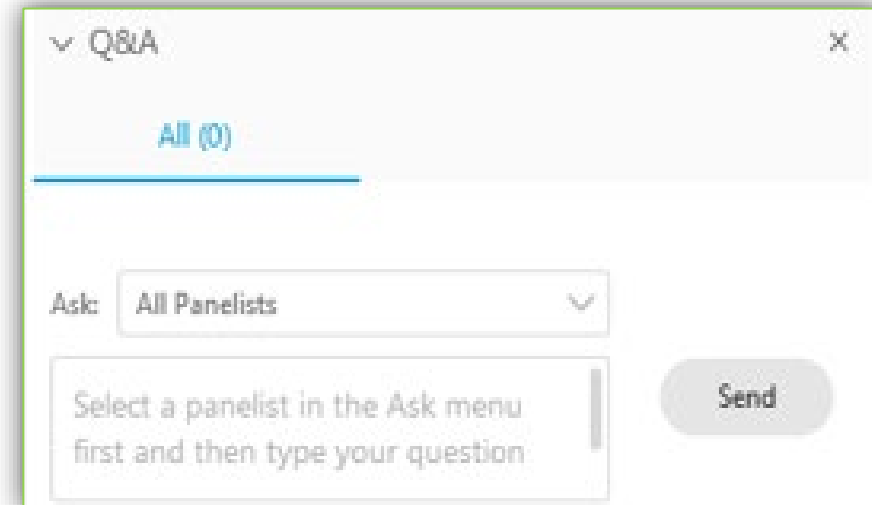

PCP QIP Background

- Pay-For-Performance (P4P) program that provides financial incentives to drive quality health outcomes for Partnership members.
- Offers measure performance reporting, member data, training, and technical assistance.
- All PCPs with Medi-Cal assigned members are automatically enrolled into the program.
- Structured by *Core Measurement Set* and *Unit of Service Measures*.
- Measurement Year (MY) 2024 PCP QIP P4P highlights.
 - 365 provider sites from 122 parent organizations.
 - ~\$51.9 million distributed incentives.





Contract Amendment for P4P Participation

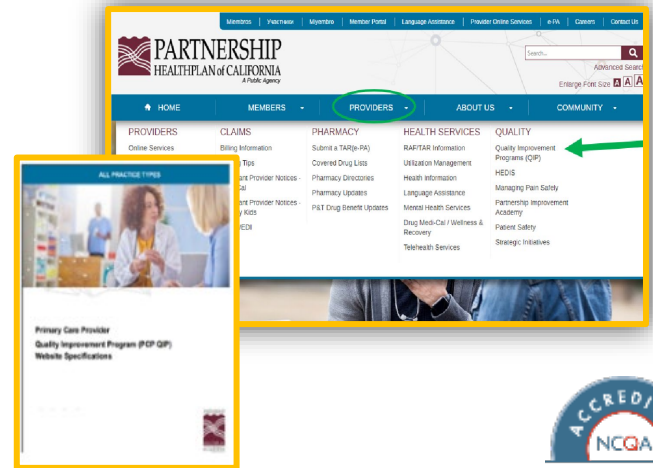
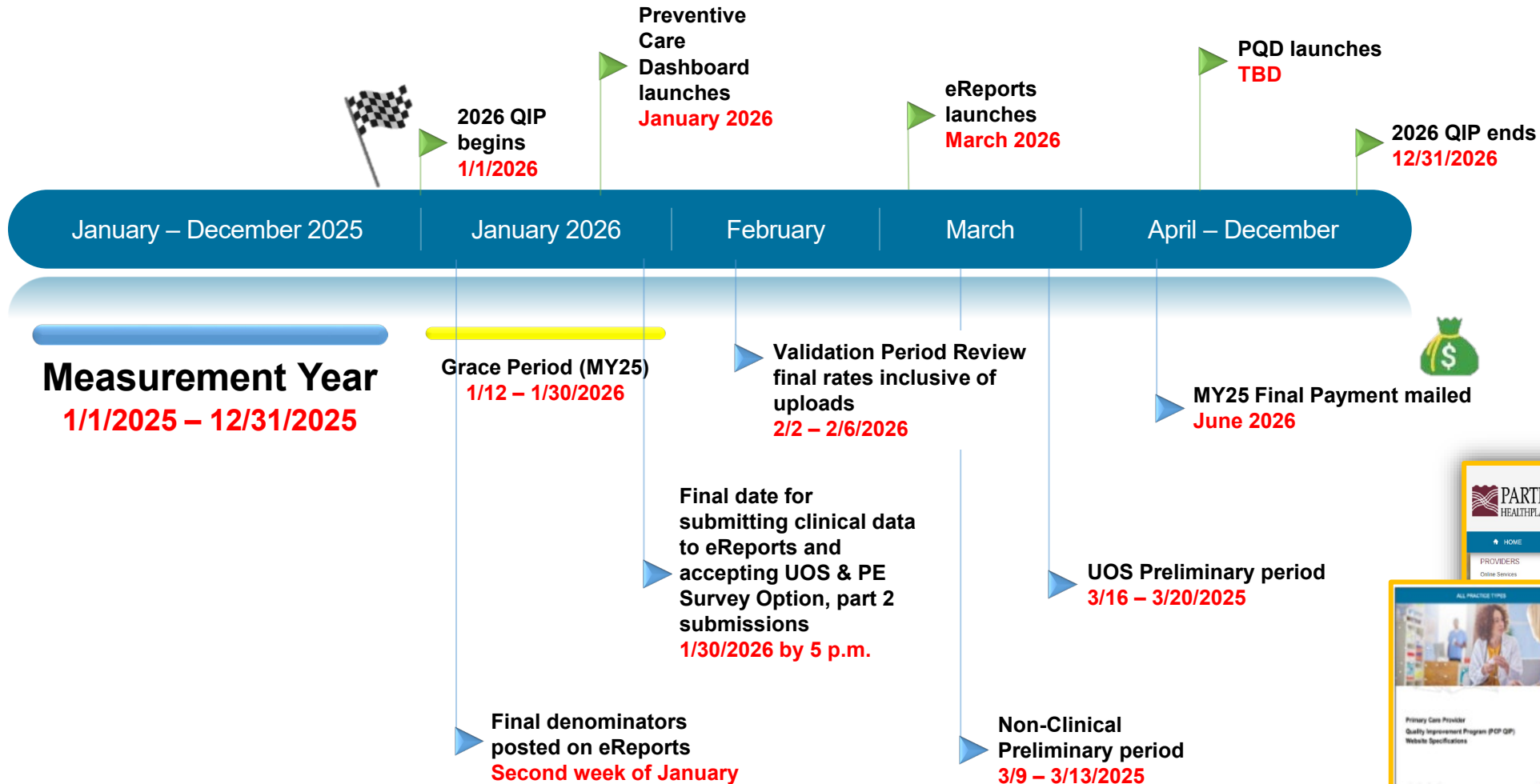
- As of January 1, 2026, federal law *42 CFR 438.3(i)(3)* requires network providers participating in P4P programs to execute an agreement inclusive of specific program details.
- Contract amendments have or will be sent electronically via DocuSign and by mail.
- Return signed amendment to Partnership's contracting team *no later* than **Wednesday, December 10, 2025**. This ensures your organization can continue participating in our existing quality incentive payment programs for MY2026.
 - Partnership *will not* accept amendments signed after December 10, 2025.
 - New federal law requires annual contract amendments, so Partnership is planning for earlier engagement next year.

Timeline Terms

- **Continuous Enrollment:** Requires members to be assigned to your parent organization for nine out of 12 months between January 1 – December 31, 2025.
 - Site where members are assigned as of December 1 will be the “anchor” for inclusion in final denominators.
- **Exclusion Deadline:** Last day to submit clinical and small denominator exclusions request.
- **Grace Period:** Timeframe after the end of measurement year to submit data for members in final eReports denominators.
- **Validation Period:** Timeframe after the eReports grace period to review and validate uploads and final rates.
- **Preliminary Period:** Timeframe after the end of measurement year to review and validate non-clinical data via PQD or Unit of Service measure submissions within preliminary statements.

Important MY2025 Closeout Dates

| DATE | EVENT |

| December 31, 2025 | End of Measurement Year. |
| January 1 – 11, 2026 | eReports under maintenance. No provider access to eReports or Partnership Quality Dashboard (PQD). |
| January 12, 2026 | eReports, with your final denominators, is available. |
| January 12 - 30, 2026 | Grace Period to upload data on services delivered between January 1 and December 31, 2025. |
| January 1, 2025 – January 15, 2026 | Submissions for clinical exclusions. |
| January 15 – 30, 2026 | Submissions for small denominator exclusions. |
| January 30, 2026, by 5 p.m. | Last day to submit Unit of Service & Patient Experience – Survey Option, Part 2 submissions, small denominator exclusions and upload data for the 2025 PCP QIP. |
| February 1 – 8, 2026 | Validation Period: eReports frozen so providers can review final rates inclusive of uploads. |
| March 9 – 13, 2026 | Preliminary period for Non-Clinical data. |
| March 16 – 20, 2026 | Preliminary period for Unit of Service measure submissions. |

Timeline Checklist and Upload Best Practices



Timeline Checklist

- **Last week of December 2025:** Download copies of eReports measure reports.
- **January 1 – 11, 2026:** eReports will be under maintenance. During this time, scrub clinical charts and check for any missing screenings or visits from members that can be uploaded for QIP credit.
- **January 12, 2026:** Site final denominators available in eReports. Members who did not meet Partnership continuous enrollment during MY2025 (nine of 12 months) are removed from measure denominators.
- **January 12 – 30, 2026:** eReports grace period for sites to review their final denominators and upload any missing DOS for members remaining in their denominators.

Timeline Checklist


- **January 15 – 30, 2026:** Submissions for small denominator exclusions are accepted for unsuccessful outreach efforts for non-responsive members. A provider site must have < 15 members in a measure to qualify.
 - Three outreach attempts must include: One written outreach attempt, one verbal outreach attempt, and a third outreach attempt of the site's choice. (Text messages are accepted as an outreach effort.)
- **January 15, 2026:** Last day to submit clinical exclusions for MY2025.
 - A clinical measure exclusion is a submission by a provider for a member which whom they feel does not meet the measure qualifications and should be excluded from a measure. A medical director will review these requests on a case-by-case basis.
- **January 30, 2026:** Last day to submit small denominator exclusions, UOS submissions, and upload any missing data for measurement year 2025.
 - Submissions and uploads must be completed by 5 p.m.

Timeline Checklist

- **February 1 – 8, 2026:** Validation period in eReports. Providers to review final rates inclusive of uploads.
- **March 9 – 13, 2026:** Validation period for Non-Clinical data. Providers to review and validate their Non-Clinical data in PQD.
- **March 16 – 20, 2026:** Validation period for Unit of Service measure submissions. Providers will receive their preliminary statement(s) via email, and they are to review and validate these documented submission(s).

Upload Best Practices

- Prior to uploading a measure DOS and/or value for a member, check eReports to make sure the DOS or value **has not already been captured** by a claim, CAIR, or lab data.
- When filling out an upload template, **do not manipulate the template** and make sure you **input required information as instructed**.
- Save a copy of your upload template **AND** screenshot a picture of the successful upload message after uploading your template.
- Allow up to **seven business days** for the eReports refresh to show your upload. If after seven days you do not see your upload, please email QIP@partnershiphp.org.

How to get started:

1. Click on the measure name (red box) THEN, Click one or more Provider Name(s) from the Provider name dropdown.
2. To view another measure drilldown: Re-click the measure name (blue box) OR the Revert button upper left corner AND return to step 1 or 2 above.



- In the PQD, Non-Clinical Drilldown dashboard, you can view reporting for each Non-Clinical measure. View these reports during the Non-Clinical Preliminary Period. The Non-Clinical Preliminary period is **March 9 – 13**.
- Patient Experience results will be available via your Unit of Service preliminary statements. The Unit of Service Preliminary period is **March 16 – 20**.
- Throughout the measurement year, it is a best practice to view / download your non-clinical reports and validate your data for accuracy.

Questions and Answers

Q: Will the Partnership Quality Dashboard (PQD) be updated with final denominators by Monday, January 12, 2026?

A: The PQD will refresh in January 2026 with December 2025 data; however, this data will not be final. eReports is the source to list final clinical denominators after January 12, 2026.

Q: Will the PCP QIP Kick Off Webinar slides be available to providers?

A: Yes, these slides will soon be available to providers on the [PCP QIP webpage](#).

Q: Can additional lines be added to the manual upload templates?

A: The eReports upload templates allow a maximum of 100 lines per submission. Please do not manipulate these templates by adding additional lines. If the upload templates are manipulated in any way, your submission may not be accepted.

Questions and Answers

Q: If a small denominator exclusion is submitted and approved for a measure, how does this impact earnings of potential points? Example: I have eight total members in my denominator with two compliant members, but five members are removed.

A: Five members would be removed from your original denominator of eight, which turns your final denominator count to three. Your final numerator / denominator counts would be 2/3. For more explanation and examples on small denominator exclusions, please refer to the small denominator section within our detailed specifications manual in eReports.

Q: How do providers register for the ABCs of Quality trainings?
