“The Adult Protective Services (APS) program investigates reports of abuse and neglect of elder and dependent adults. An “elder” adult is any person 65 years of age or older. A “dependent” adult is any person 18 through 64 years of age who has physical or mental limitations which restricts their ability to carry out normal activities or protect their rights. Social workers provide services that are focused on stopping the abuse and then helping the individual to develop a plan to maintain themselves in a safe environment.”

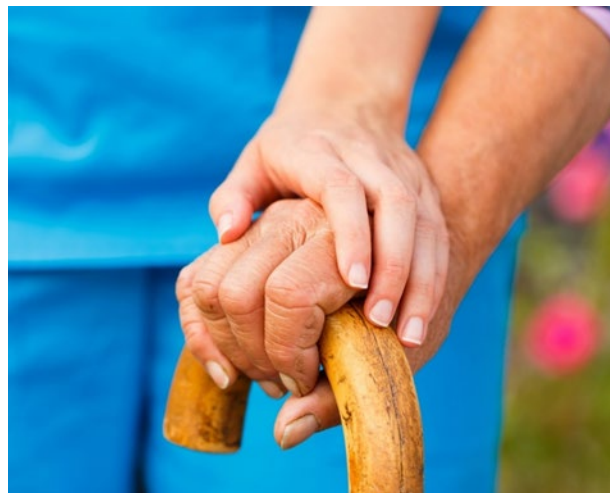
