The Pengerang Integrated Complex (PIC) is currently progressing towards start-up and the crude feed-in is forecasted in the middle of Q2 with good progress being made on the HPU rectification. The reassurance activities is also underway to support the start-up plan.

Repair activities on the ARDS and DHT units also remain on schedule to meet the required start-up date.

Furthermore, booster shot vaccinations for those above 60 years old and Sinovac primary vaccine receivers have currently reached 97%. This will further ensure minimal disruptions due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Happy Hormone Talk webinar series

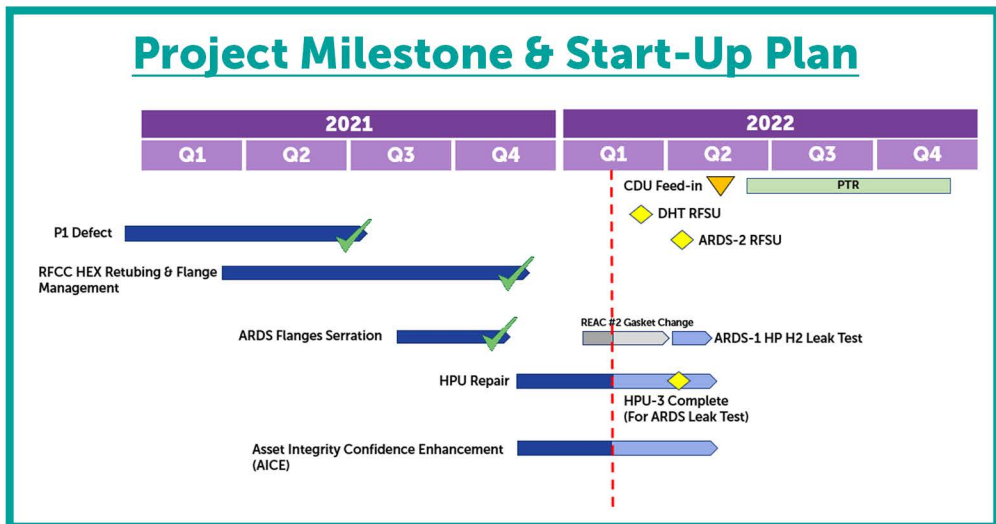
