### **HPU Progress On Track**

PENGERANG INTEGRATED COMPLEX: In gearing up towards the first crude-in in Q2 this year, it is good to get to know the latest progress of the HPU, a critical element in PIC's start-up readiness.

It has been updated that the HPU rectification is on track to be completed by April 2022 as planned. Tube replacements have also been completed and the catalyst loading (chemical process to produce hydrogen) is currently ongoing.

Consisted of three trains with the hydrogen capacity of 110,000 Nm3/hr each, HPUs 1, 2, 3 overall progress have exceeded the planned target at 85.2%, 88.7% and 92.2% respectively.

Fact Box: What is HPU?

HPUs are Hydrogen Production Units for hydrotreating units such as Atmospheric Residue Desulphurisation (ARDS), Diesel Hydro Treating (DHT), Kerosene Hydro Treating (KHT) and Naphtha Hydro Treating (NHT) which are used to remove sulfur and other contaminants. Hydrogen is also used for ARDS leak test before the start-up.

## **Facilities Readiness for** Start-up

### Water

The Projek Air Mentah RAPID (PAMER), Raw Water Treatment Plant (RWTP) and Storm Water Outfall (SWO) are set to support PIC's start-up and ready to accelerate its growth on to the next frontier.

As PIC's sustainable water resources and ecosystem backbone, these integrated infrastructures will power up PIC's end-to-end business operations, from refining petroleum products to manufacturing petrochemical products to producing power, steam and other critical utilities needed for operational sustainability.
