PIC's Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) employs energy-efficient and economical treatment methods of wastewater that complies with the Malaysian and International Finance Corporation (IFC) discharge quality standards.

Effluent Transfer Management, which includes effluent transfer request, has increased its effectiveness in managing effluents from customers while online compliance monitoring has propelled ETP towards operational excellence in managing its regulatory compliance.

Embracing the 3Rs of Reduce, Reuse and Recycle, efforts are taken to continue increasing the amount of treated effluent to be recycled. The ultimate objective is to turn PIC into a zero liquid discharge (ZLD) facility.

Idris shared on the status of the Asset Integrity Confidence Enhancement (AICE) programme including the key focus areas that covers inspection and testing, rectification update, findings summary as well as manpower readiness. Production Planning SGM Mr. Abdulilah A. Razhi also briefed on PIC's start-up readiness as well as the latest on the integrated start-up schedule which includes HSSE, Manpower, Operations, Engineering and Maintenance Readiness and Internal Audit Assurance.

A site visit then ensued to the Hydrogen Production Unit (HPU), Diesel Hydro Treating Unit (DHT), Main Control Building (MCB) 601, the Emergency Command Centre (ECC) and Central Emergency and Fire Services Response (CEFS). The fruitful visit was another step in the direction of start-up readiness towards the first crude-in expected in Q2 this year.
