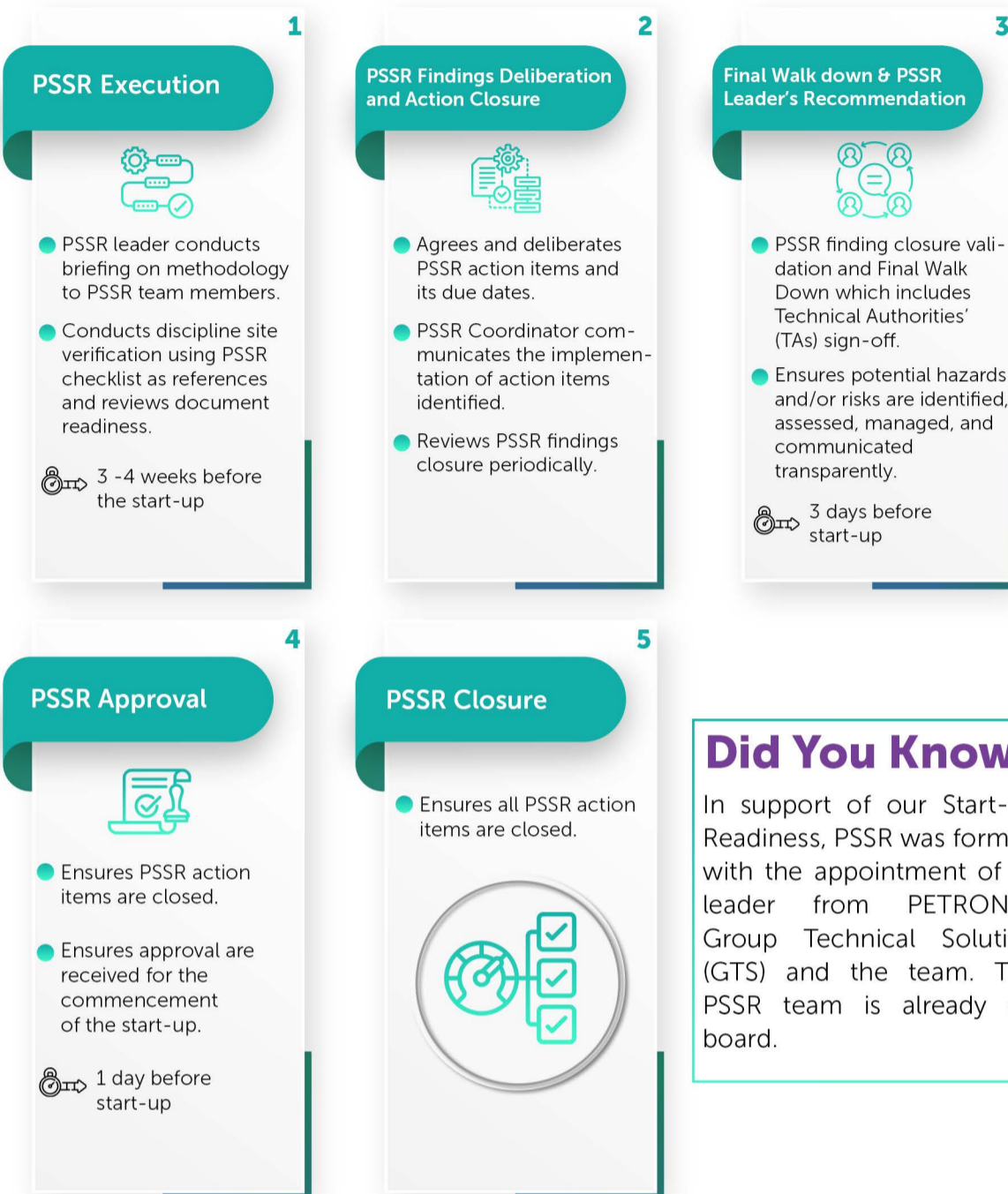


Find out what you need to know about the Pre-Startup Safety Review (PSSR) Process Flow and their responsibilities:

At the Pengerang Integrated Complex (PIC), natural gas is one of the main commodities ready to support the upcoming start-up and operations.

The imported Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) is received, stored and re-gassed at the Regasification Terminal Pengerang (RGTP). A supply of approximately 700 million standard cubic feet of natural gas is used to operate PIC during normal operations. This puts PIC on track as a sustainable complex, utilising cleaner source of energy.
