



Another win for PIC

On March 22, Pengerang Integrated Complex saw the generation of its first solar energy of 4MWp for the Solar PV Rooftops at Non-Process Building Complex. The project was driven by the Solar Project Team consisting of PRPC, PRPC UF, PETRONAS Power Sdn Bhd (PPSB), MIE Industrial Sdn Bhd and Huawei.

The project, which was developed and approved by the PRPC Board on 27th February 2020, is part of a Solar Master Plan to deliver up to 400MWp of solar power in the next 5 years and capitalize the full potential of the unused land and rooftop surfaces in PIC.

This first generation of solar energy gave a great contribution towards the achievement of the first milestone in Phase 1 of the PIC Solar Project. It is also the first PPA (Power Purchase Agreement) under the Growth Blueprint of PIC and help to improve overall park competitiveness for PIC.

This achievement fits perfectly with PETRONAS' 'Moving Forward Together 50.30.0' aspirations, especially on **Net Zero Carbon Emissions** by 2050. This is critical for PRPC in realising its vision to be **THE Regional Petrochemical Park**.

At PIC, the hub for solid petrochemical products storage and delivery by land is situated at the Solid Product Warehouse (SPW). This record-breaking automated clad-rack warehouse can accommodate a 21-day inventory of 84,672 addresses via the Automated Storage and Retrieval System (ASRS).

Sulphur and containerised petrochemical products that are delivered to customers by sea, pass through the Solid Product Jetty (SPJ) at the south of PIC. Equipped with two container berths and one sulphur loading berth, SPJ has the capacity to accommodate 1,200-TEU container vessels and sulphur ships of between 5,000 and 15,000 DWT.

Both facilities are ready and eager to support the awaited PIC start-up and operations.
