### **Crude-in milestone achieved!**

On 6 May 2022, PRefChem achieved one of its much anticipated milestones which is the crude heater firing of the Crude Distillation Unit (CDU). This momentous progress is a testament to the hard work from all PRefChem personnel who have been tirelessly working towards this milestone. Your commitment and perseverance is commendable.

#### **Key activities**

Final equipment testing are conducted before the start-up of units to ensure pumps, instrumentation, and all areas are fully functional prior to start-up

Some setbacks were discovered and successfully resolved.

CDU unit undergoes tank to tank long loop circulation.

Inventory build-up into the vessels.

Column utilising start-up material such as Naphtha and Diesel for dewatering activities to minimise upset possibilities during start-up.

Comprehensive final rounds of testing were conducted to ensure there are no glitches or technical disruptions prior to the firing date.

#### What have we achieved?

As a result from the firing of the CDU heater, we have successfully and safely rundown five products, namely Atmospheric Residue (AR), Atmospheric Gas Oil (AGO), Kerosene, Naphtha and Liquified

Petroleum Gas (LPG)

Kindly be informed that PRefChem has commenced its Crude-in activity on 6 May 2022. From this point onwards, Start-up activities are anticipated to continue until July 2022.

## The Start-Up is around the corner

**What To Expect?** 

Excessive Flaring Event

During start-up, all off-spec gases will be burnt in the dedicated steam-assisted flare unit to prevent overpressure.

### How to Minimise the Flaring Volume

Conduct start-up flare monitoring and strategise on minimisation plan to reduce flaring volume.

Perform an early start-up of the Flare Gas Recovery Unit (FGRU) to recover the flare gas once the minimum requirement is met.

### How to Ensure Minimum Impact to Surrounding Community

Conduct day and night environmental monitoring programme which includes ambient air quality monitoring and noise monitoring

Any excessive flaring will be communicated with shift manager on duty to ensure proper adjustment from respective units

As part of our responsibility, PIC will continue to communicate with employees and communities within the Pengerang vicinity and assure its operations and business are conducted with the highest standards and professionalism for the safety of its employees, surrounding communities and the environment.
