When they first came on board, some were skeptical but to many of us, it was hopefulness that came to mind. After almost two years, we needed to Start-up the plant, fast. Alhamdulillah, with the Asset Integrity and Confidence Enhancement (AICE) team working together with PRefChem team, we achieved our first milestone on May 6.

In the span of five months, the AICE programme was 100% completed for early start-up units with no major findings. As at 24 April, the overall completion was at 85.5%. Risk Assessment conducted on the remaining 15% of the AICE scope for uninspected static equipment and piping resulted in medium risk rating which will be mitigated accordingly.

Although it is too early to celebrate, it is still and will always be a win in our book of achievements. With the start-up, we hope to achieve many more milestones, together as a team. It is time to capitalise on our strengths and reignite our purpose: To become THE Regional Petrochemical Park.
