Start-Up Journey:

Kerosene Hydrotreating Unit

On 16 May 2022, straight run kerosene was **successfully charged** into the Kerosene Hydrotreating Unit (KHT). The KHT is designed to treat the straight run kerosene from the Crude Distillation Unit (CDU) by removing contaminants such as organic sulphur and nitrogen, using high purity hydrogen.

Additionally, the KHT produces Hydrotreated Desulphurised Kerosene as the final product for Jet Fuel, Dual Purpose Kerosene (DPK) and the blending component for Diesel products.



KHT Start-up activities by Area 1B team

Significant Processes for KHT Start-up

1 Feed Section

- Remove water from feed stream
- Filter out particles up to 25 μm
- Build up inventory for kerosene feed

02 Reactor and Compressor Section

- Preheat the mixture of raw kerosene and Hydrogen (H2)
- Treat raw kerosene in Hydrodesulphurisation (HDS) Reactor



04 Product and by Products

- Hydrotreated (HDT) Kerosene
- Wild Naphtha
- Sour Gas



03 Stripper Section

 Strip out Hydrogen Sulfide (H2S) and light hydrocarbons from kerosene stream

What's Good in Pengerang?

Bandar Penawar is one of the most popular choices to live among staff who work at the PIC due to its top amenities in Pengerang. The area surrounding Bandar Penawar was a deep jungle and it was only explored in 1972 by Southeast Johor Development Authority (KEJORA), a body established to develop the areas in southeast Johor. Few settlements have already existed in southeast Johor for hundred of years along Johor's west coast and along Johor River, including FELDA which were established in the 60s. Today, Bandar Penawar is growing rapidly, equipped with almost all basic public facilities and infrastructure such as mosques, multi purpose hall, sports complex, bus terminal, schools, colleges, fire station, police station, post office, library, clinics, food courts, parks and recreational centres.
