Start-Up Journey: What's Next? Continuous Catalytic Reformer (CCR)

The CCR is designed to process the hydrotreated heavy naphtha from the NHT to produce high octane reformates such as gasoline blending components.

The CCR also produces sweet off-gas H2 rich gas for the Refinery pressure swing and un-stabilised sweet LPG for SGP.

On 16 May 2022, we have successfully charged Hydrotreated Heavy Naphtha from NHT into CCR.

Significant Activities

Section

- Heavy Naphta (HN) feeds to CCR comes from the bottom of NHT Naphtha splitter.
- Sulfiding agent is added to prevent coke formation in fired heaters and on
- Feed is mixed with recycled hydrogen and preheated to required reactor

Reaction Section

Compression and High Pressure (HP) Adsorption Section

- Cools down compressed gas and separates the condensed Hydrocarbon.
- Removes Chloride from H2 rich gas.
- H2 rich gas is routed to the Continuous Catalytic Reformer Refinery
- Recovers maximum quantity of Liquified Petroleum Gas
- Remove chloride from separating liquid.
- LPG is routed to the SGP Unit.
- Cooling down product for storage.
