

Oesaru Ostrich Farm

Desaru Ostrich Farm is one of the largest ostrich farms in Asia and it is well-known among international tourists to this country. Located in Kampung Changi, Teluk Ramunia, there are over 200 ostriches at this farm and visitors can get up close with young baby chicks to full size adult ostriches. An ostrich caretaker will be your personal tour guide during the visit, showing and guiding you inside the farm. The admission fee is RM12 for an adult and RM8 for a child. If you feel brave enough, you can try to feed and ride the world's biggest bird species. Visitors can also sample some delicacies and dishes of ostrich meat and eggs at the farm's restaurant.
