

PIC Units in recovery mode

The recent tripping incident at the Pengerang Cogen Plant (PCP) during the TNB Southern grid failure had resulted into loss of steam of the plant. The incident was attended to swiftly by the team who was on alert and an emergency shutdown was performed professionally.

The units that survived were Crude Distillation Unit and Hydrogen Production Unit, while the rest of the units were safely put on shutdown mode. We are now in the recovery phase and nine units have recovered; Saturated Gas Plant, Kerosene Hydrotreating Unit, Naphtha Hydrotreating Unit, Continuous Catalytic reforming, Sulphur Recovery Complex (Amine Regeneration Unit, Sour Water Stripping Unit and Sulphur Recovery Unit).

Units that are currently still recovering are the Diesel Hydrotreating Unit, Atmospheric Residue Desulphurisation Unit 1 and Steam Cracker Unit. All Petrochemical units are currently on standby mode and awaiting feedstock availability from the Steam Cracker.

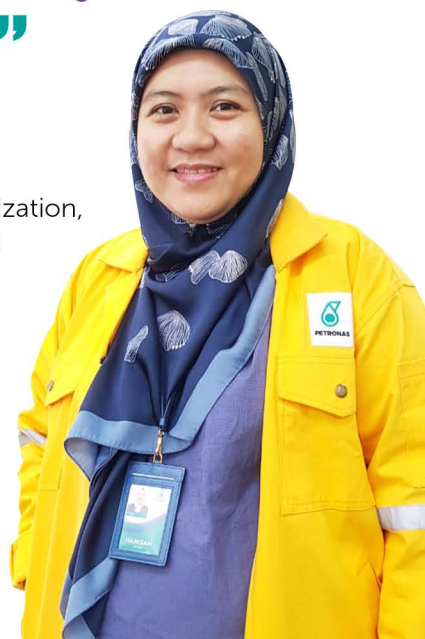
