HDPE and SSU

- We are pleased to announce first batch of Solid Sulphur has been successfully transported to Solid Product Jetty.
- HDPE started Ethylene feed in on the 2 August 2022 for debugging activities.
- The Sulphur Solidification Unit (SSU) has been successfully startup and is in operations.



Recovery Phase

- There are 11 units that have already recovered which are the Saturated Gas Plant, Kerosene Hydrotreating Unit, Naphtha Hydrotreating Unit, Continuous Catalytic reforming, Sulphur Recovery Complex, Amine Regeneration Unit, SourWater Stripping Unit, Diesel Hydrotreating Unit (DHT), Atmospheric Residue Desulphurisation (ARDS) and Linear Low Density Polyethylene (LLDPE) and Sulphur Recovery Unit.



- The unit that is still recovering is the Steam Cracker Unit.
- DHT is producing the rundown product.
- ARDS 1 module 1 restarted, and have started producing product.
- Currently, the High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) is undergoing debugging activities.
- LLDPE have started and it has produced prime product.

What's Next?

- ARDS 1 module 2 is ready for catalyst sulphiding activity.
- Resid Fluid Catalytic Cracking (RFCC) Feed in and stabilisation.
