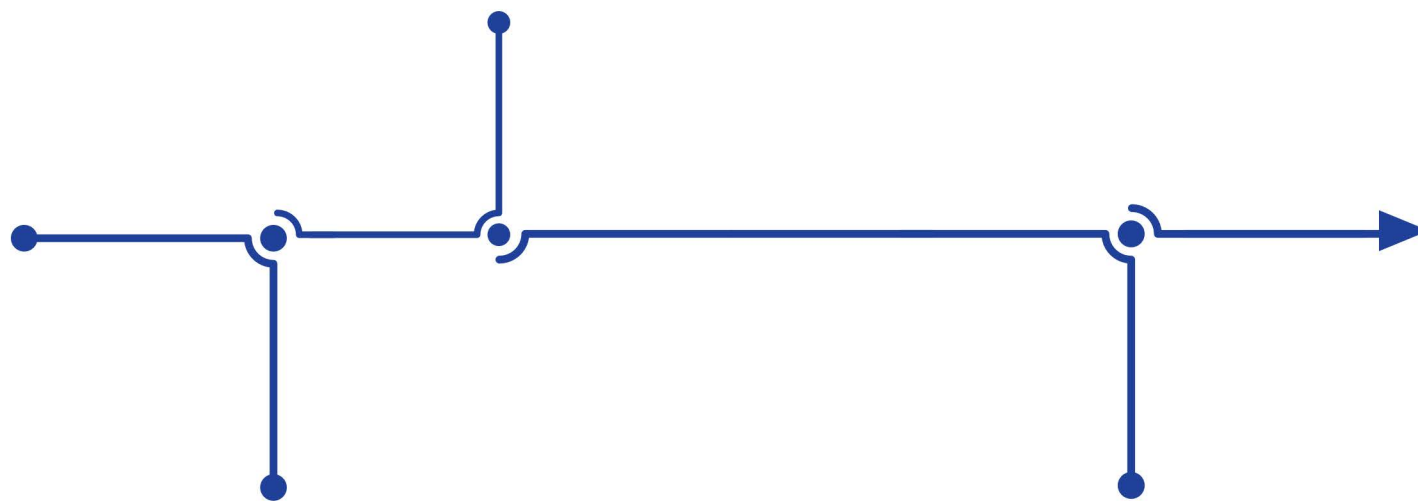


Start-Up Journey

PRU, CNHT 1 CN, CNHT 2 HCN, MCN and TAME

- All PRU products are to rundown.
- Cracked Naphtha Hydrotreater Unit 1 (CNHT 1) Cracked Naphtha has successfully feed in on 20 August 2022 to respective unit and all products are to run-down.
- Cracked Naphtha Hydrotreater Unit 2 (CNHT 2) Heavy Cracked Naphtha (HCN) and Medium Cracked Naphtha (MCN) have successfully feed in on 23 August 2022. Stabilisation is currently in progress.
- Tertiary-Amyl-Methyl-Ether-Etherification (TAME) Unit start up is in progress.



ARDS, RFCC, EOEG, PRU and SCU

- ARDS, RFCC, EOEG, PRU and SCU
- Atmospheric Residue Desulphurisation (ARDS) 1 M2 sulfiding is completed on 7 August 2022.
- ARDS 1 M2 AR has started feed in on 7 August 2022.
- Residual Fluid Catalytic Cracker Unit (RFCC) has started feed in on 10 August 2022. Stabilisation is in progress.
- Ethylene Oxide/Ethylene Glycol (EOEG) Unit has started ethylene and oxygen feed in on 11 August 2022. Stabilisation is in progress.
- Sweet LPG has successfully routed to Propylene Recovery Unit (PRU) on 13 August 2022.
- Steam Cracker Unit (SCU) is currently in operation and all products are to rundown

What's Next?

- High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) continuous run.
- Polypropylene Spherizone (PP SPZ) Unit start up.
- Methyl Tertiary Butyl Ether Unit (MTBE) start up.

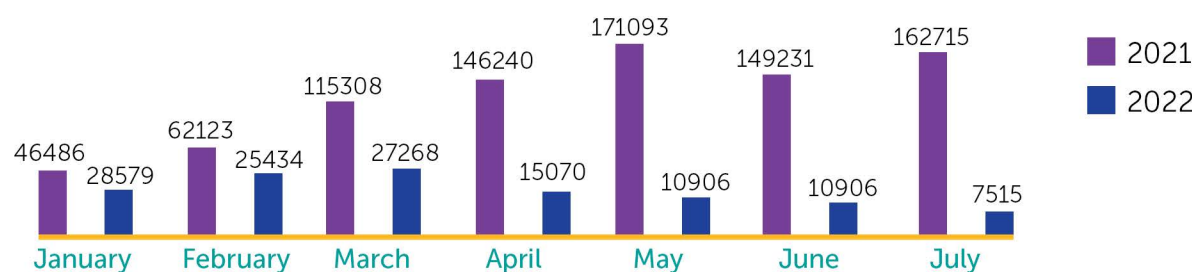
Need for Speed? Not in PIC, please.

The PIC Speed Violation Report showed a huge reduction in speed violations from 171,000 violations in the month of May 2021 to 7,515 violations in July 2022. The speed violations recorded were sorted by speed limits of 25km/h, 40km/h and 50km/h in four categories of violations.

This huge reduction was attributed mainly to warnings sent to the person exceeding the speed limit as well as signages put up at violation-prone areas such as the Temporary Camp Facility (TCF), OSBL and Persiaran Utara. The violations were usually committed during peak hours at 9am and 12 noon.

The violation will trigger the GPS which is managed by service provider (Hertz) and a monthly report will be generated, from which the warnings will be issued to Cat 3 & 4 speed offenders. While this is a great improvement to ensure PIC remains as a safe workplace, it is hoped we can maintain safe driving habits even when we are driving outside of PIC.
