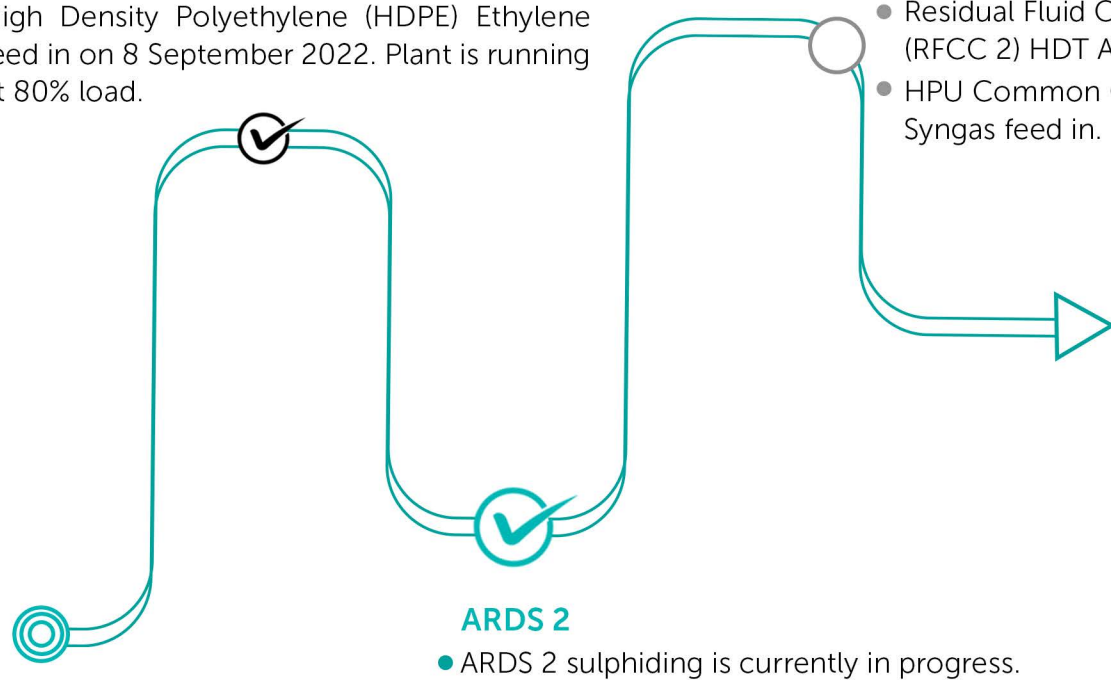
Start-Up Journey
