PRefChem lends a hand to fishermen community



PRefChem introduced its first Bubu programme to the fishermen community of Kampung Lepau as part of its CSR to continuously improve and impact the lives of others especially the communities who are closest to us.

Bubu is a piece of fishing equipment traditionally made of bamboo frame with rattan rings, widely used by fishermen at uneven seabed terrains with coral reefs. Now, bubu is mostly made from galvanised netting and iron metal of various shapes and sizes which traps the fish from escaping.

One of the recipients Encik Mohamad Zakuan Yacob said, "I am grateful that PRefChem truly lives up to their mission to care for the community and enrich our lives. I strongly believe this contribution will lift the spirit of our fishermen community and we would be able to help increase the number of fishes and sea creatures that will be caught."

The fishing equipment was handed over to 16 fishermen from Kampung Lepau whose livelihood is primarily dependent on fishing. Each fisherman received fishing materials which included galvanised hexagonal wire netting as well as 10 kg of metal rod wire. Also present was Head of Manufacturing, Datuk Hashim Majid.

PIC launches

myRegister, myPIC, myPRPC

In line with PIC's digitalization aspiration, three digital platforms were launched yesterday - myRegister, myPIC, and myPRPC. The platforms were launched to address pressing matters and pain points heard from staff, contractors, and visitors of PIC.

As part of our drive to achieve the PIC Vision, myPIC will promote PRPC's image as PIC Park Manager via a single platform for access to Park Rules as well as services and communications with staff of companies and contractors working in PIC. It will also feature information on common facilities and links to request for services and promotions, weekly publication of stories behind the scenes such as PIC Weekly and FACES behind the Start-up, Park Rules, HSSE Awareness tips as well as PIC Sustainability Agenda.

The myRegister was developed through the collaborative effort from PRPC and PETRONAS Digital Sdn Bhd to resolve the issues plaguing entry registration into PIC at pace, such as lengthy processing time, multiple separated touch points and a massive paper trail. The introduction of myRegister will replace the Visitor Management System and issue the PIC Security Access Card (PSAC) which will be digitised, centralised and streamlined. This also applies to visitors coming in.

On the other hand, the myPRPC will cater for PRPC and its GoCs' staff. Developed as a secured internal communication tool, employees now have access to a one-stop centre and depository platform for all PRPC related information and materials. It is also expected to help in reducing email clutter as information can be communicated in an improvised and digitized way instead of sending and receiving an enormous amounts of email blasts on a daily basis.
