What happened?

 On 27 October 2022 there was an unfortunate major fire incident at the interconnecting pipe rack in Pengerang Integrated Complex (PIC)

Leadership Team Engages with Staff





The Leadership Team has carried out several engagements last week with PRPC UF shift staff to share their experience, feedback or concerns with the management. The intent is to hear out issues and concerns by the staff which will be further taken into consideration.

The highlight of the engagement was on the importance of a clear communication and procedural flow when high-risk incidents, having dedicated emergency lines for staff and contractors, the procurement of Emergency Response Vehicle (ERV), and improvements in the processes and infrastructure in PIC. Other issues raised include the current manpower requirement, staff capability development, succession planning as well as Family Day in hopes to increase the morale of the staff.

Each engagement lasted about an hour in MCB601, OSB401 and OSB402 in four shifts; Shifts A,B,C and D. With a more laid back engagement such as this, the management had a clearer picture of what goes on at the working level and managed to zoom into immediate to long-term issues which needed attention.

It is hoped the staff will continue to render their support and keep giving feedback to ensure that the communication lines are kept open at all levels. The LT Conversation session with Tier-2 Ips will be undertaken by URSC HR Workstream under the Motivation focus area.
