DOSH, BOMBA, DOE visit PIC

Regulatory bodies comprised of DOSH, BOMBA and DOE were briefed on the recent fire incident followed by a site visit to the location of the incident.

Each of the visit was led by PRPC SVP & CEO, En Kamal Bahrin Ahmad accompanied Head PRPC HSE En Irwan Latif, Head PIC Operation and Complex Management En. Mohamad b Nasir, Head SCSM En. Izzuddin A Ghani and other PRPC and UF Head of Divisions. During the session, PRPC shared updates on PRPC incident management and preliminary findings identified.

They were also updated on formation of the UF Recovery Steering Committee (URSC) which is intended to steer the recovery and rebuild process which is expected to complete and restart by early next year.

Among the government authorities who visited were DOE Director Dr Mohd Famey Yusoff, Acting Johor BOMBA Director Encik Mohd Rizal bin Buang and DOSH Director Encik Hudsin bin Che Mat. The support required from these authorities will strengthen the PRPC effort in ensuring all recoveries and repair work are conducted according to regulatory requirements.







ARAMCO Malaysia, PRefChem collaborate on mangrove planting

ARAMCO Malaysia and PRefChem have recently organised a mangrove conservation tree-planting programme in support of Johor's efforts to develop Pulau Tanjung Surat as an ecotourism destination. The CSR programme is located in Tanjung Surat, Johor, where it is anticipated that approximately 9,000 trees could be planted there.

In addition to ecotourism, one of the primary objectives of the mangrove planting programme is to preserve the environment for future generations. Aside from the environment, this programme would benefit the local economy by establishing the area as a destination where visitors can learn more about mangroves and conservation efforts.

Over 50 volunteers, including PRefChem Cares volunteers and ARAMCO Malaysia representatives, participated in the programme on 12 November 2022. ARAMCO Malaysia's programme will be a three-year collaboration with PRefChem that will generate ecotourism opportunities and improve the livelihoods of the communities closest to us.

Oil Spill Simulation A successful exercise

An oil spill crisis simulation was successfully carried out at the PT2SB jetty on Nov 2, 2022 involving Pengerang Terminals (Two) Sdn Bhd (PT2SB), Pengerang Marine Operation Sdn Bhd (PMOSB), Pengerang Independent Terminals Sdn Bhd (PITSB), Dialog Pengerang Terminals (5) Sdn Bhd (DPT5SB) and Pengerang Refinery & Petrochemicals Corporation Solid Product Jetty (PRPC SPJ). The crucial exercise was jointly organised by PT2SB and PRPC.

During the simulation, the loading arm Quick Connect/Disconnect Coupling (QC/DC) prematurely disengaged, and as a result, crude oil was spilled to sea. The ship operator immediately stopped the ship discharge pump, however the amount of crude oil spilled to the sea was already quite significant. Upon further inspection by the Department of Environment (DOE), it was advised that the situation can be considered under Malaysian Oil Spill Contingency Plan (MOSCOP) Tier 1 – Local Spill within port limit.

Proceeding further into the simulation, the DOE requested that other agencies such as Jabatan Laut, Lembaga Pelabuhan Johor, Police Marine & APMM to be informed.


Pusat Kawalan Tempat Kejadian (PKTK) was activated and the DOE lead the Oil Spill Response Operation as the Incident Commander (IC) who was assisted along with other members. Furthermore, the Jabatan Laut had the responsibility on assisting the Clean-up operation at the site.

A brief press-conference event was also organized as part of the simulation where relevant media agencies were present to cover the story from a media angle, where question and answer session was held with the communications team from PT2SB
