Giving Back to Taman Bayu Damai Community



A simple and small-scale Majlis Penyerahan Sumbangan Sekolah Agama Taman Bayu Damai (SATBD) was conducted on 9 Nov 2022 to signify the completion of work for PRPC's contribution worth RM35,000.

PRPC partnered with Koperasi Pengerang Johor Berhad (KOPERANG) to paint the main gate, flagpoles, four toilets, 22 doors and 60 pillars throughout the school. In addition, mirrors in the toilets and the 22 doors were also replaced with brand new ones before painting commenced.

"Besides replacing items and painting works, we've also contributed sets of projectors with white screens, 45 study chairs with flip tables and cupboards for the benefit of teachers and 450 students at the school," said En Izzuddin in his speech.

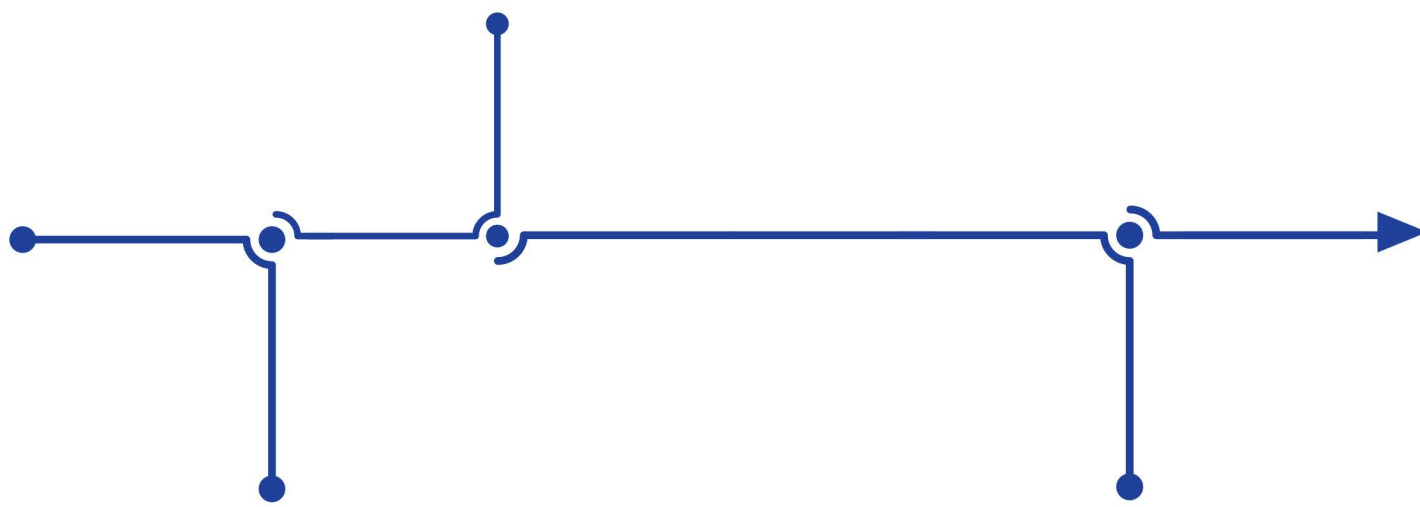
