# **PRPC Offers Flood Relief Aid**









For a handful of PIC staff and surrounding communities, the flood situation is a very possible reality during this monsoon season. According to the Kota Tinggi District Officer Datin Paduka Hazlina Jalil, 65 hotspots are at risk of being inundated or cut off during floods in this district. This involves 53 villages, ten housing estates, two Felda areas and four main roads.

With the intention to assist the authorities in responding to those in need during floods, PRPC contributed three units of Ford Rangers on loan to Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) and two units of Modenas Pulsar NS200 motorcycles to Jabatan BOMBA dan Penyelamat Malaysia (BOMBA).

During the handing over ceremony on 17th Nov 2022, En Rahmat Siran, Head Security PRPC, handed over the keys to Jimi Osmera Osman Ibu Pejabat Daerah (IPD) Kota Tinggi, during the ceremony held here in PIC. In a later event on 25th Nov 2022, SVP & CEO of PRPC En Kamal Bahrin Ahmad gave the mock key to YAS Dato' Sri Ts. Mohammad Hamdan Wahid, Director General of BOMBA, a symbolic of the change of ownership from PETRONAS to BOMBA.

These contributions came on the heels of of the Johor PETRONAS Disaster Relief Programme conducted at the District Office on 18th Oct 2022. This initiative is a part of PETRONAS' pledge to help affected flood victims, announced last December.


