PRPC carries out Fish Release Programme



On 22 Nov 2022, PRPC Water successfully conducted the Fish Release and Population Survey Programme at the Empangan Seluyut, Kota Tinggi, Johor. The ecosystem perseverance event was led by Encik Norazam Ismail, Manager of PRPC Water, along with 15 of his staff members.

In complying with the Water Environmental Management Plan (EMP), PRPC plans to monitor the restriction of fish migration, both upstream and downstream, and create opportunity in fishery or aquaculture that will benefit more than 5,000 people of the population, especially local villagers and Felda settlers along Sungai Seluyut.

The water area is approximately 2,832.79 hectare in size, whereby 230 million litre of raw water per day is supplied to PIC for its operations. There is also an amount of 30 million litre of raw water per day that is ready to be supplied to the State-owned Lebam Dam for users in Pengerang.

A total of 20,000 juvenile fish that consists of Ikan Patin (Pangasius) and Ikan Lampam Jawa (Barbonymus) were released at five identified locations at Seluyut Dam in support of PRPC's Sustainability Development Agenda. In realising this goal, a total of 100,000 juvenile fishes are expected to be released by 2025.

In conjunction with this program, a survey was also conducted to study and monitor the native fish population density and species diversity, while collecting data and observing the ecosystem's condition, in terms of its quality and health spectrum. Subsequently, it is predicted that this survey may help identify if there are any invasive alien fish species that could potentially cause harm to the current ecosystem.

MyHSSE rolling out soon



Since 2021, GHSE and PRPC HSE have collaborated towards a one-stop centre for Health, Safety, Security and Environment (HSSE) application systems. Effective 1 Jan 2023, all PRPC Group of Companies and contractors will be able to use this system.

The team, in close collaboration with subject matter experts, oversees and integrates all digital systems under the umbrella of Group HSE. With focus on value creation, the team aims to create and maintain systems that meet and comply with PETRONAS Technical Standards (PTS) so that once any OPU that uses the system, they automatically comply with technical standards equivalent to HSSE requirements.


Soon, all users can access the following myHSSE systems; Incident Management (IM), Unsafe Act Unsafe Condition (UAUC), Action Management (AM) and e-Chemical Management System (eCHEMS). The users of the application system will be able to explore the systems through the official myHSSE website (https://myhsse.petronas.com/).

On 23 & 24 Nov 2022, a train the trainer session has been held with a total participants of over 100 attendees. The objective of the session was to train identified OPU trainers for myHSSE Unsafe Act Unsafe Condition (UAUC), Action Management (AM) and Incident Management (IM) in preparation of the rollout in PRPC on 1 Jan 2023.

 Unit is running steady with four furnaces on Naphtha Cracking. RFCC 1 (What's Next)RFCC 1 HDT AR feed in.


