He also introduced the Gemba Walk cycle and some tools used during the cycle. Gemba Walk is the term used to describe a tour/observation of the work's location. The original Japanese term comes from Gembutsu, which means "real thing." It also sometimes refers to the "real place."

The session continued with active discussion on the key tools: Value Stream Mapping (VSM), Process Cycle Efficiency and 8 types of waste. The tools are used to identify and eliminate non-value-added activities in a process. By analyzing the flow of materials, information, and actions required to deliver a product or service, VSM helps pinpoint inefficiencies and improvement
