

# **MEASURES TAKEN TO CONTAIN THE SPREAD OF COVID-19**

## ACCESS TO POLIMI GRADUATE SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT

Students, staff and any other persons wishing to enter POLIMI Graduate School of Management can access these premises ONLY if they have **no Covid-19 symptoms** (in particular no signs of flu or a high temperature)

A radiometric thermal camera is installed at the entrance to POLIMI Graduate School of Management, which automatically measures body temperature of everyone entering the building. Body temperature will be checked in compliance with current data protection legislation. A person with a temperature above 37.5°C will be not allowed to enter.

### PERSONAL CARE

# Personal hygiene is important:

- Wash you hands frequently, if possible with soap and water, otherwise use the sanitising gels located at various points around the building and near lecture rooms; clean your hands before entering.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Avoid hugging and shaking hands.
- Cover you nose and mouth when sneezing or coughing.

### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT - PPE

It is strongly recommended that you wear a FFP2 face mask at all times when you are on site at POLIMI Graduate School of Management, especially when you are indoors and in rooms with other people where social distancing (1 meter) is difficult to maintain, with the exception of those who have an ailment or condition that is incompatible with wearing a face mask.



#### **CLEANLINESS AND VENTILATION IN CLOSED AREAS**

POLIMI Graduate School of Management will ensure that all areas are kept clean and disinfected, using specialised external services, with particular care given to the surfaces that are touched the most frequently, toilet facilities and common areas. The cleaning service will use licenced cleaning products with anti-virus action, as indicated by the Italian National Institute of Health.

All rooms and areas will be well-aeriated with good air circulation, where possible using natural ventilation.

#### MANAGING A SYMPTOMATIC PERSON

If a student shows signs of Covid-19 (high temperature, respiratory symptoms, etc.) while at POLIMI Graduate School of Management, **the student must be isolated immediately and given a FFP2 face mask**, if not wearing one already. Arrangements will be made to send the student home immediately, where they must follow all the rules currently in place for any suspected case of Covid-19.

When put in isolation, the symptomatic person will be placed in a room/area away from any other person, as long as they are sufficiently at ease.

The emergency number 112 should be called ONLY IF strictly necessary.

If you are confirmed to have Covid-19, you must follow the procedures set by the local health agencies for rules on quarantining and returning to the School. POLIMI Graduate School of Management will work with the competent health authorities to identify your "close contacts", so that the authorities can put in place the necessary and desirable quarantine measures.
