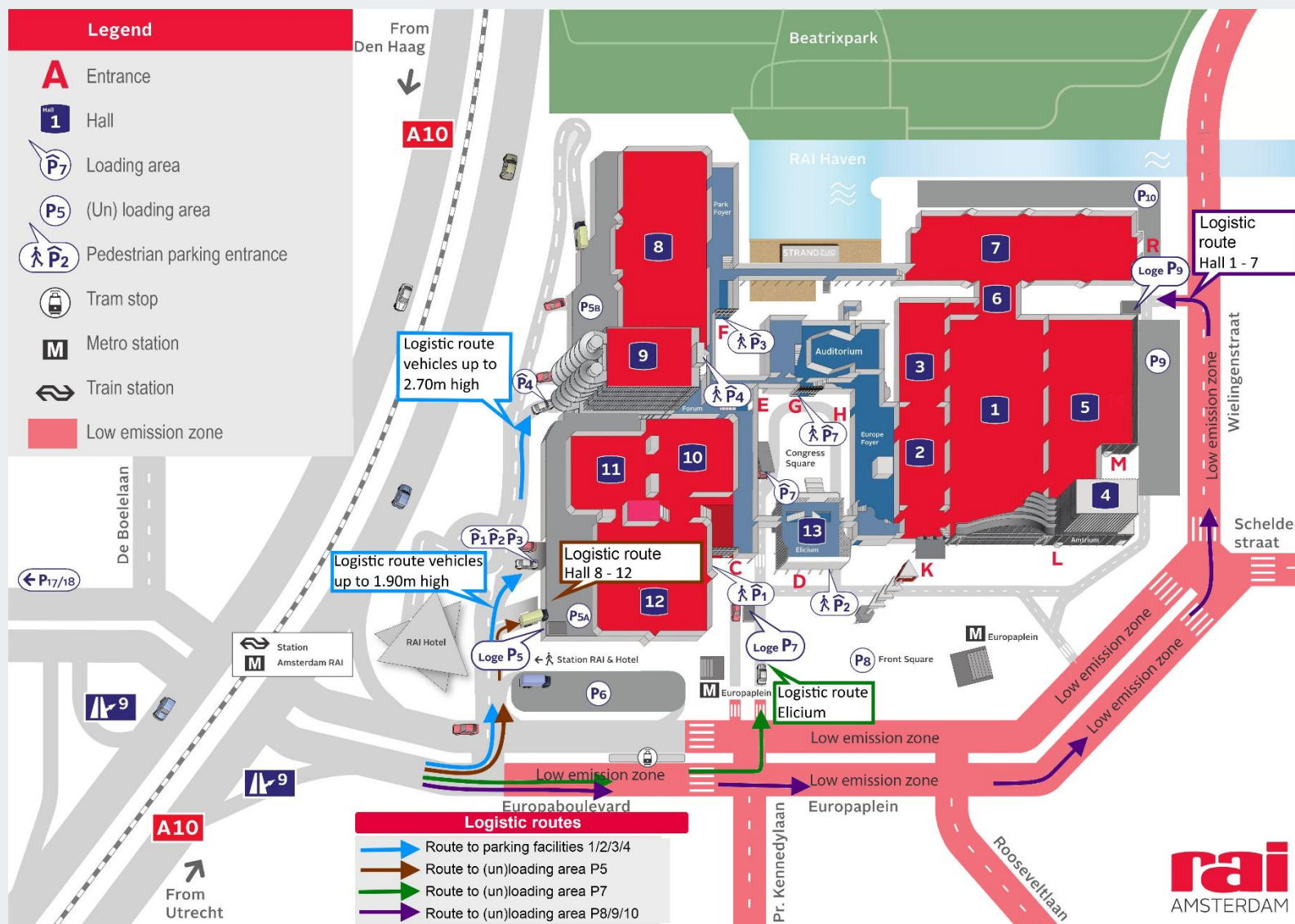

This festive event, created for and by the people of Amsterdam, will quite literally take place on the A10 - the city's ring road. This unique celebration will involve major road closures around the ring, which will affect access to RAI Amsterdam throughout the weekend.

Closures and alternative routes

This information is subject to change.



Friday 20 June from 19:00 to 21:00

Closed:

- A10 exit S109 (RAI Amsterdam side)
- Europaboulevard between De Boelelaan and Maaslandstraat (in both northbound and southbound directions)

Alternative route:

- Via the A2 > Utrechtse Brug > President Kennedylaan



Friday 20 June from 21:00 to Sunday 22 June at 17:00

Closed:

- A10; entire inner and outer ring
- A2; at the junction with the A9

Alternative route:

- A9 exit AMC/IKEA > Holterbergweg S111 > Joan Muyskenweg > Utrechtse brug > President Kennedylaan > Europaboulevard
- The A2 in the direction of Utrecht (leaving the city) will reopen on Saturday 21 June at 17:00
