Our teams are highly experienced in treating the full range of speech, language, cognitive, voice and swallowing conditions, including those related to stroke, traumatic brain injury, Parkinson's disease, multiple sclerosis, post-concussive syndrome, and cancer.

Conditions treated include:

- Disorders creating problems with sequencing sounds, or slow, weak or uncoordinated speech
- Aphasia and other conditions that may compromise listening, reading comprehension, verbal, or written skills
- Cognitive disorders affecting concentration, perception, orientation, memory, problem solving and reasoning
- Voice conditions caused by overuse or an injury to the larynx (voice box)
- * Swallowing disorders, which can be diagnosed with modified barium swallow test or a fiberoptic endoscopic evaluation (*available at Rochester General and Unity hospitals only*)
